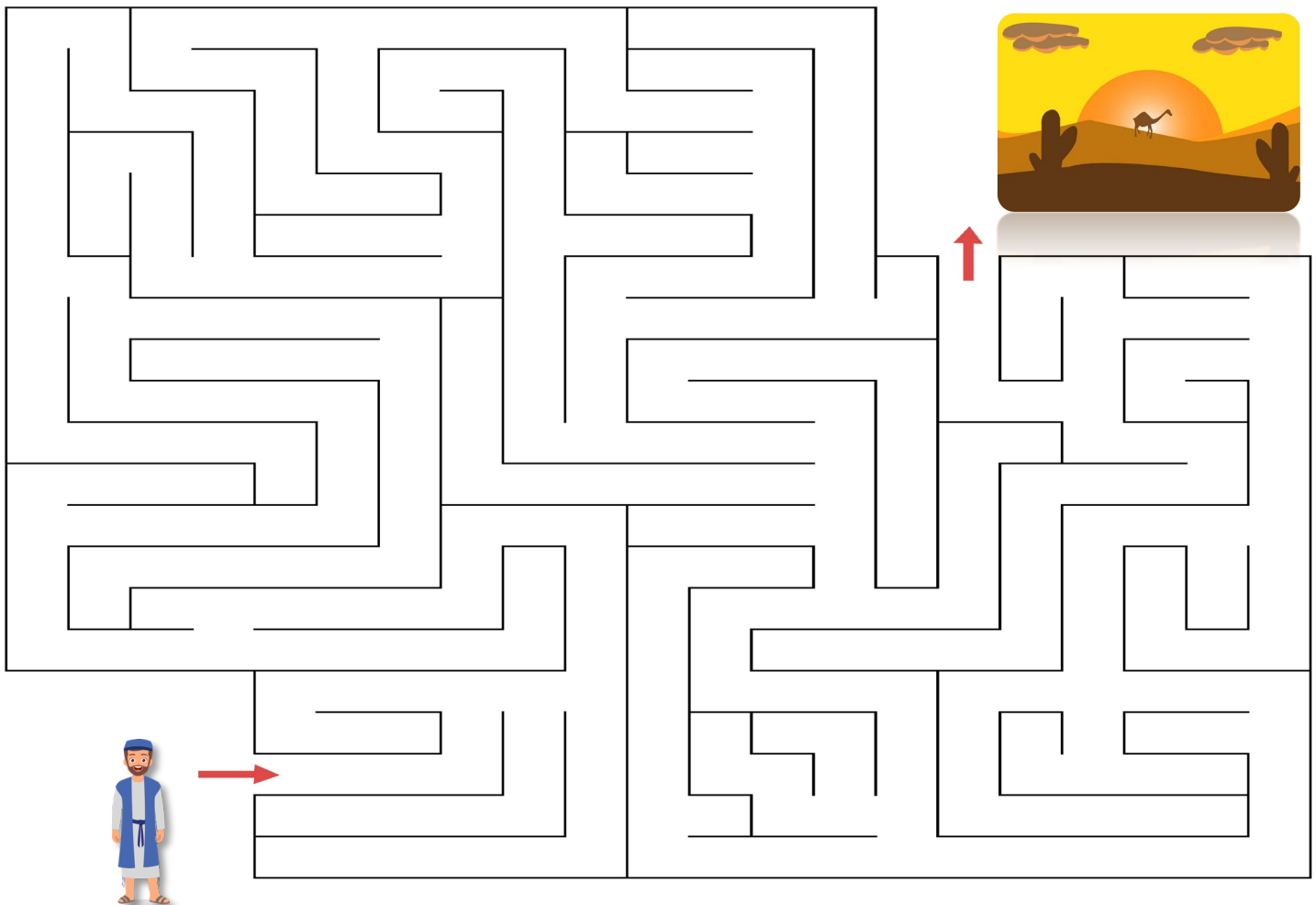
1) Why did Yochanan say to Yeshua that “I need to be immersed by you”? (Mat. 3:13-14)
