



Moses and Aaron in Egypt

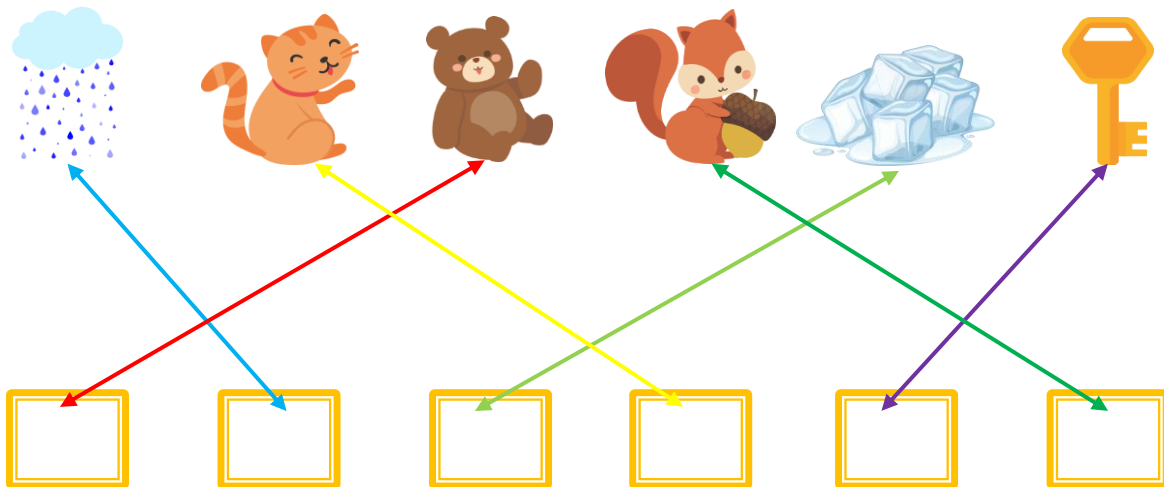
Read **Exodus (Shemot) 5**, **(Shemot) 6:1-13** and **(Shemot) 7:1-13** in the Scriptures.

Pharaoh, in addition to not listening to the warning of Moses and Aaron, he put more burden on the Hebrews.

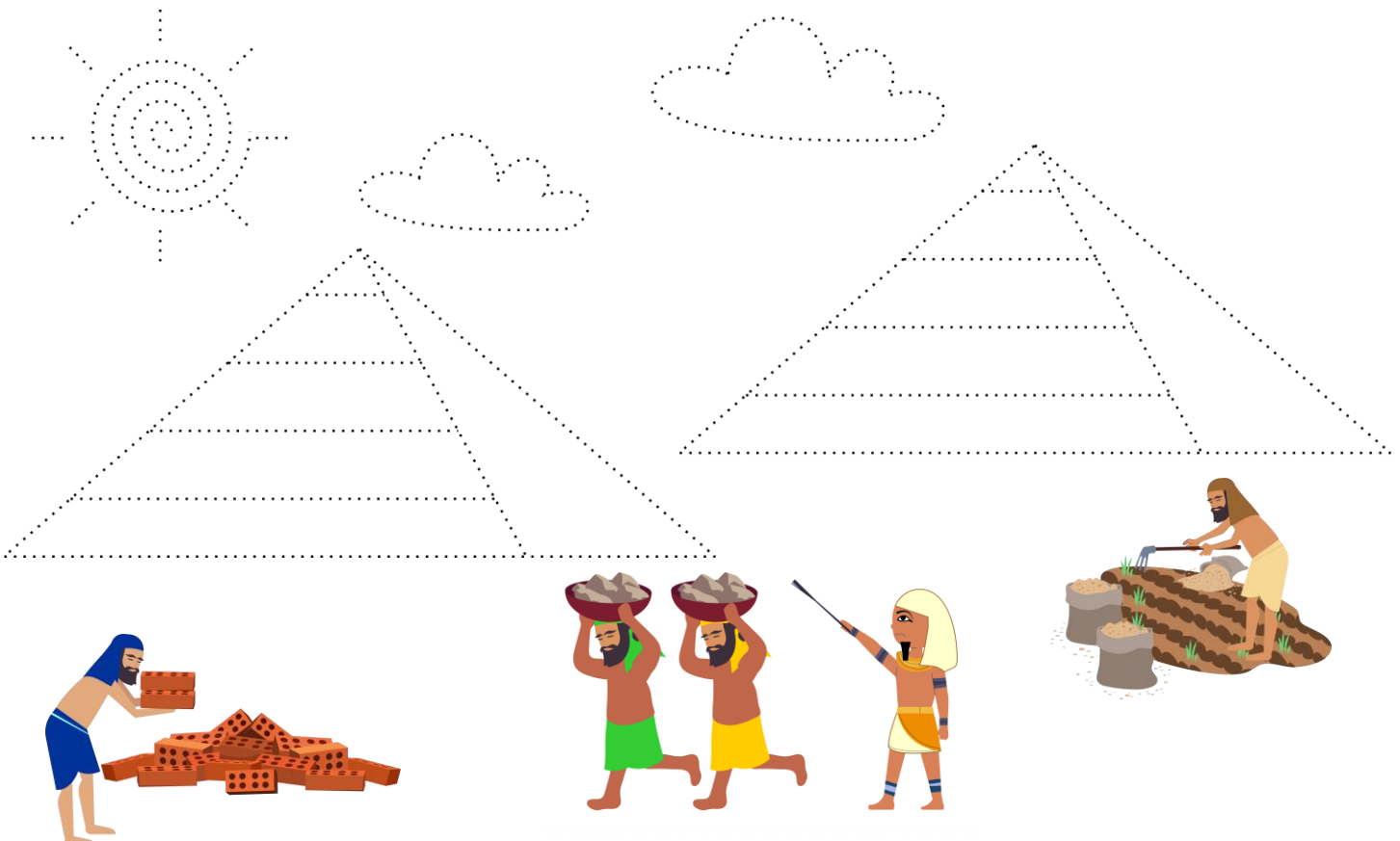


The Hebrew people were happy with their new responsibility of foraging for straw to make bricks.

What did Yahweh turn Aaron's rod into?

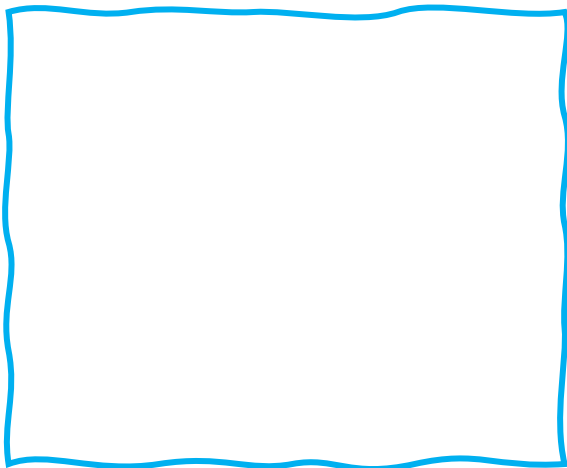
- A. Into a snake.

Did Pharaoh obey Yahweh's command?

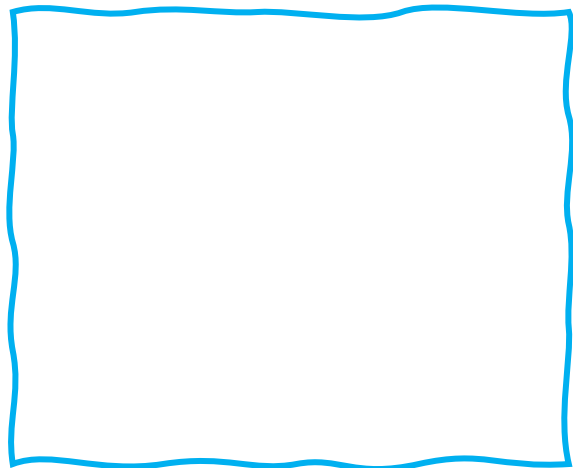

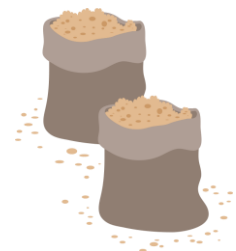
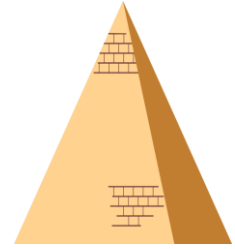
