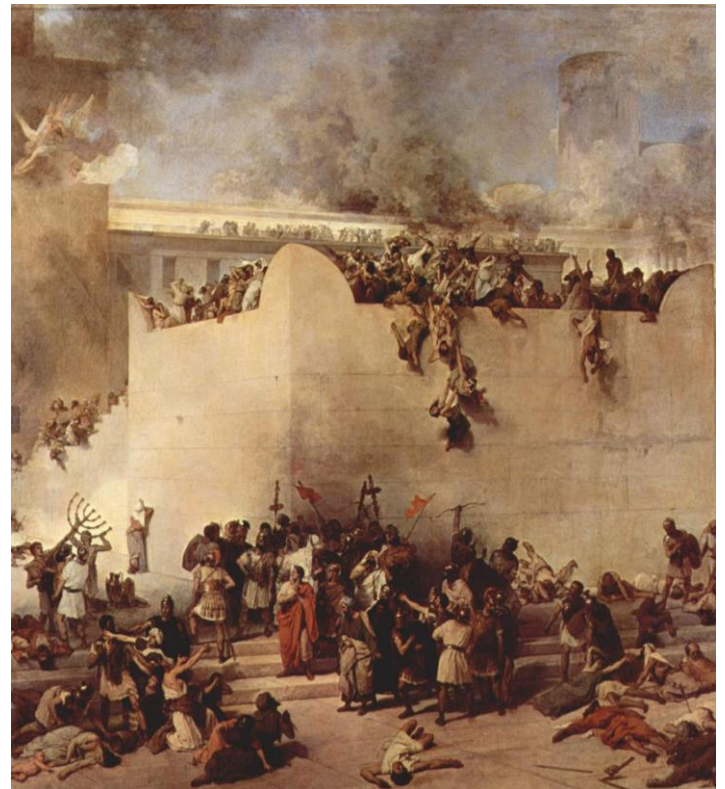
4) Why must Yahweh punish Israel for their sins? (Amos 3:1-2)

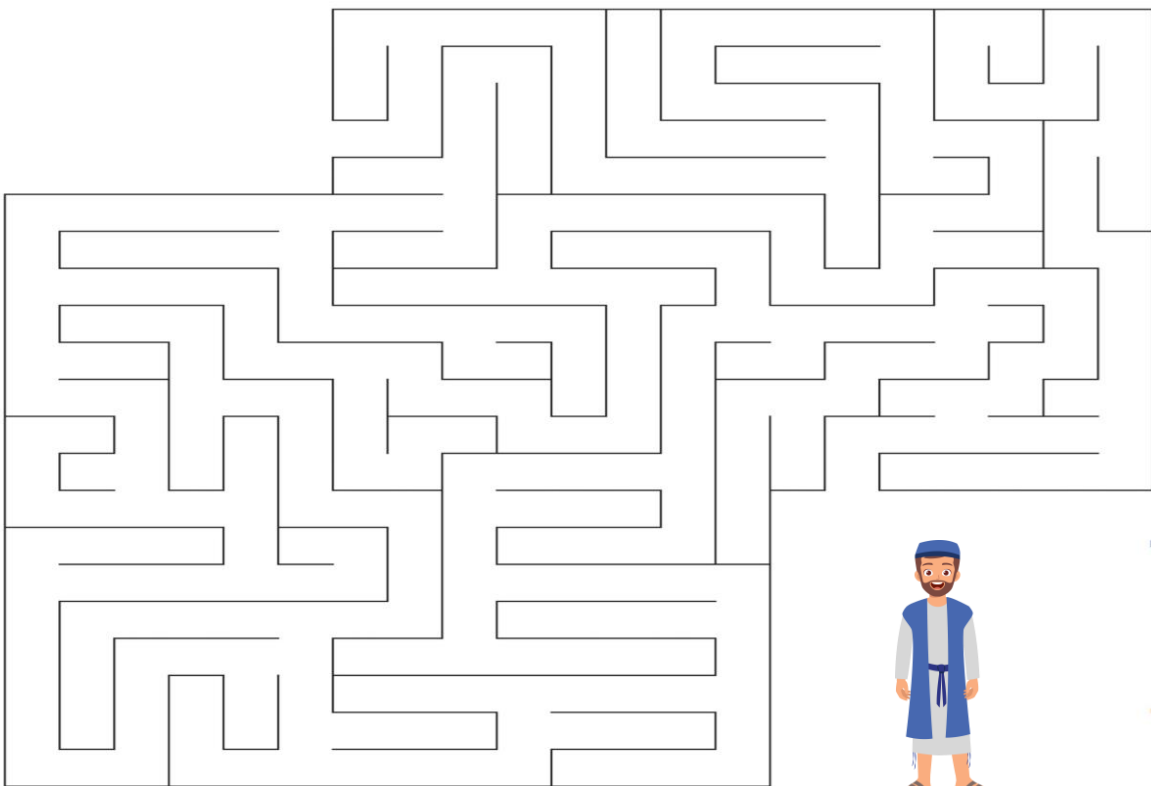
