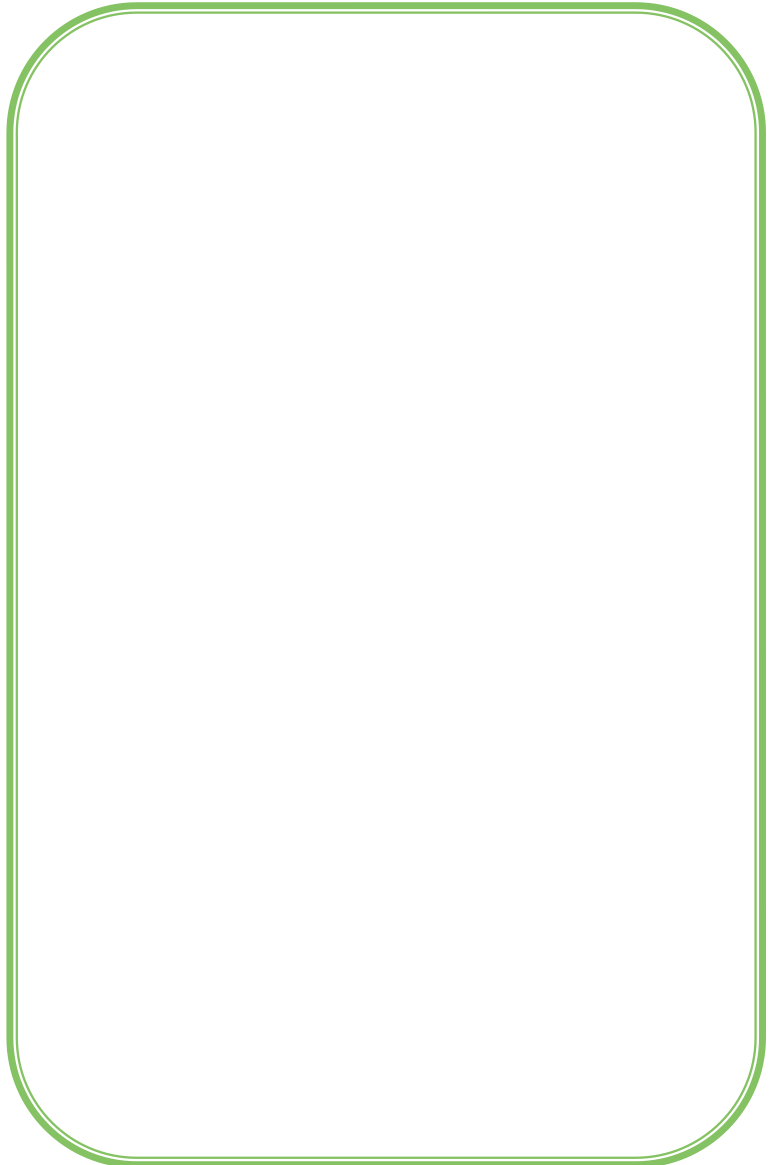


Aaron's rod buds

The rods were to be given to Aaron the high priest.



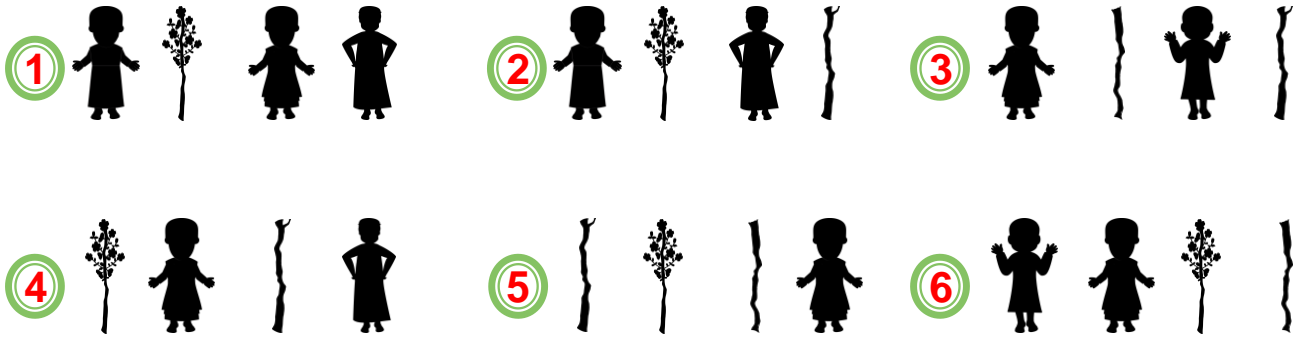
Yahweh made Aaron's rod flourish to show all the people that He chose him as His high priest.



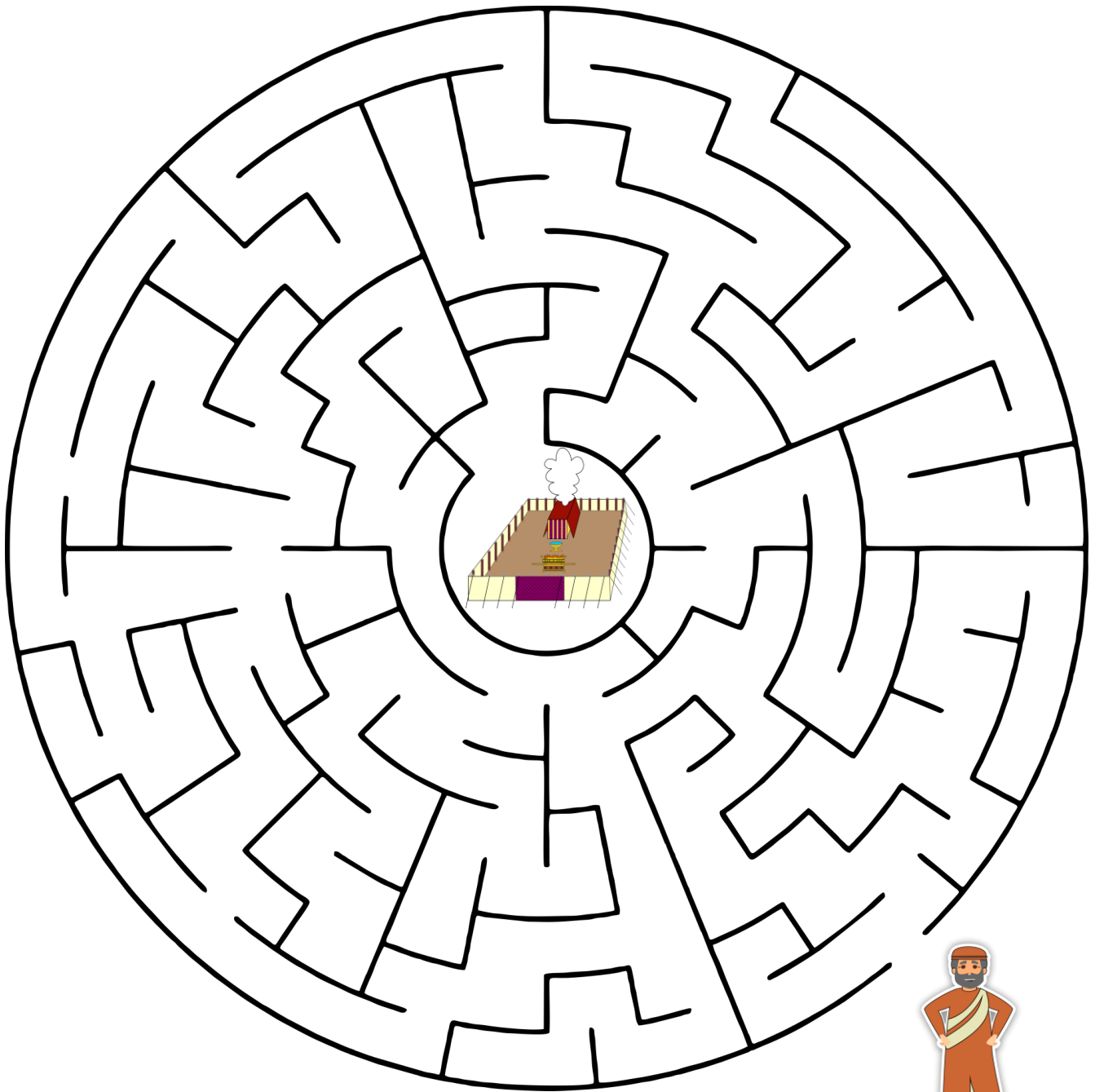
Aaron's rod was to be kept as a sign to the rebellious sons.
