



Yeshua was returning from the Jordan where He had been immersed (baptized) by Yochanan. Yeshua was carried or led by the Spirit into the wilderness. Yeshua went 4 days and 4 nights without eating or fasting. Satan tempted Yeshua by telling Him to turn stones into bread. Yeshua was hungry, so He turned the stones into bread. Yeshua did not want to bow down to Satan in exchange for the glory of all kingdoms. The prophecy said that Yahweh would send messengers (angels) to guard Yeshua. Satan wanted Yeshua to throw Himself down from a high place, but Yeshua said not to tempt Yahweh Elohim. After trying to tempt Yeshua, Satan did not want to depart from Him and kept bothering Him. Throughout Satan's temptations, Yeshua defended Himself and responded with the word of Yahweh.


You shall not tempt Yahweh your Elohim.
