It's like the wind when it blows, you don't know where it's coming from or where it's going.










In this passage, we see that Yochanan continued with his work of straightening the paths, immersing (baptizing) for repentance and preparing the way for Yeshua's message and plan. He did **not compete with Yeshua** but recognized that the Messiah must increase and he must decrease. In Luga 3:19-20, we can see that, shortly thereafter, Yochanan the immerser was

arrested by Herod and taken to prison. We learn here that Yochanan fulfilled his mission to the end, even while in prison he was faithful to the call that Yahweh gave him.



Color Yochanan talking to the Jews explaining his mission to go ahead preparing the way for Yeshua.




