


With the help of an adult read from Scripture Yochanan (John) 4:1-30

Who were the Samaritans in Yeshua's time?

The region of Samaria separated **Galilee** from **Judea**. Crossing through Samaria was the shortest way to go from Judea to Galilee and vice versa, but many Jews preferred to **divert** their route so as not to pass through there.


Why didn't Jews and Samaritans get along with each other?

The Samaritans called themselves **Israelites**, but they kept only the Torah and **rejected** all other books. Moreover, they **did not recognize** Jerusalem as a place of worship.

Yeshua left Judea and went to Galilee, passing through Samaria. Arriving at Sychar He sat down by Jacob's well. A Jewish woman came to draw water and Yeshua said to her. "Give Me a drink." The woman said to him, "Yes Master, I will give water to You and Your camels." Yeshua answered the woman, "I will give you living water from this well." Yeshua said, "Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst." "You [Samaritans] worship what you do not know, but We [Jews] do, because salvation comes from the Jews." "Yahweh is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." She did not believe that Yeshua could be the Messiah, so she filled her pitcher with water and left disappointed.


The Samaritans used to wear white, so Yeshua tells His disciples to look at the white fields for the harvest.




Help Yeshua and His disciples leave, without forgetting to make them pass through Samaria and stay there for 2 days. (Stay on the green path)






With the help of an adult, color, cut out and complete the scene of Yeshua talking to the Samaritan woman.
