The men who died of Abner, his army and Benjamin numbered 960.



Finally, when David learned that King Shaul's son, Ish-bosheth, was killed, he did the same with the one who helped in the death of King Shaul, he sent them to kill because he was not afraid to take the life of the son of the deceased King Shaul.

The story also tells us that Yonatan had a son, crippled in his feet, due to an accident while running away with his wet nurse. Do you remember his name?

DAVID IS CROWNED KING OF ISRAEL!


Finally, with the death of King Shaul's son, David is anointed king by all the elders of Israel. Read **2 Samuel 5:1-12** for the full story.
