




## **David defeats the Amalekites!**






## With the help of an adult read from the scriptures Shemuel Aleph (1 Samuel) 31:1-13




Just as David was strong in Yahweh, we must also have Elohim as our stronghold. With the help of an adult, cut out and assemble this fortress.
