Yeshua heals Kepha's (Simon) mother-in-law


Help Yeshua get from the synagogue to Kepha's (Simon) house.






With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures Marqaus (Mark) 1:40-45




For this craft you will need a cardboard or shoe box, scissors and thick wool or yarn.
