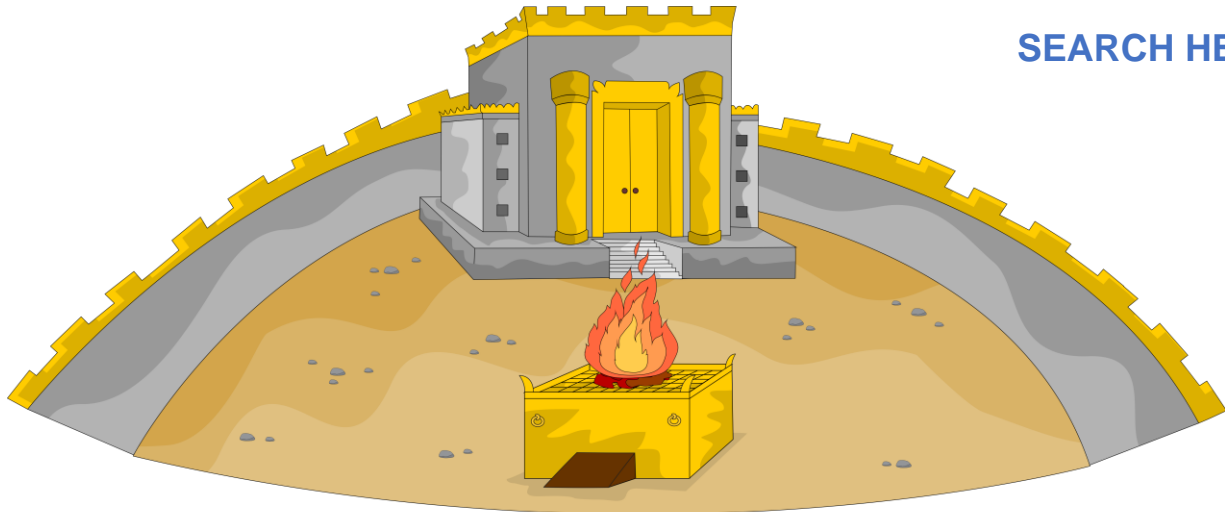

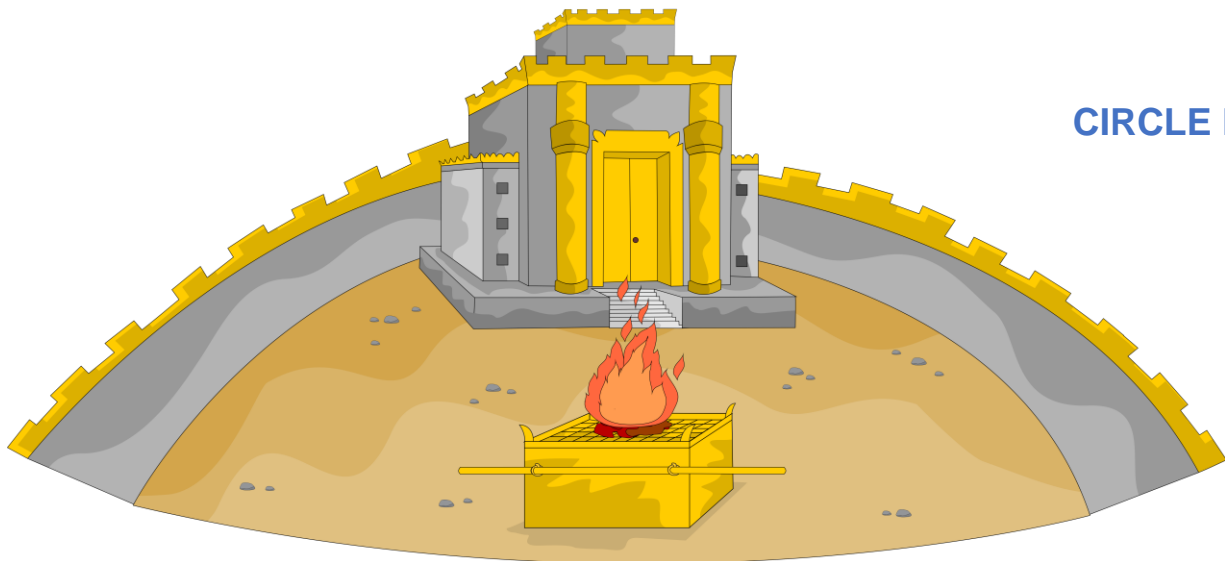

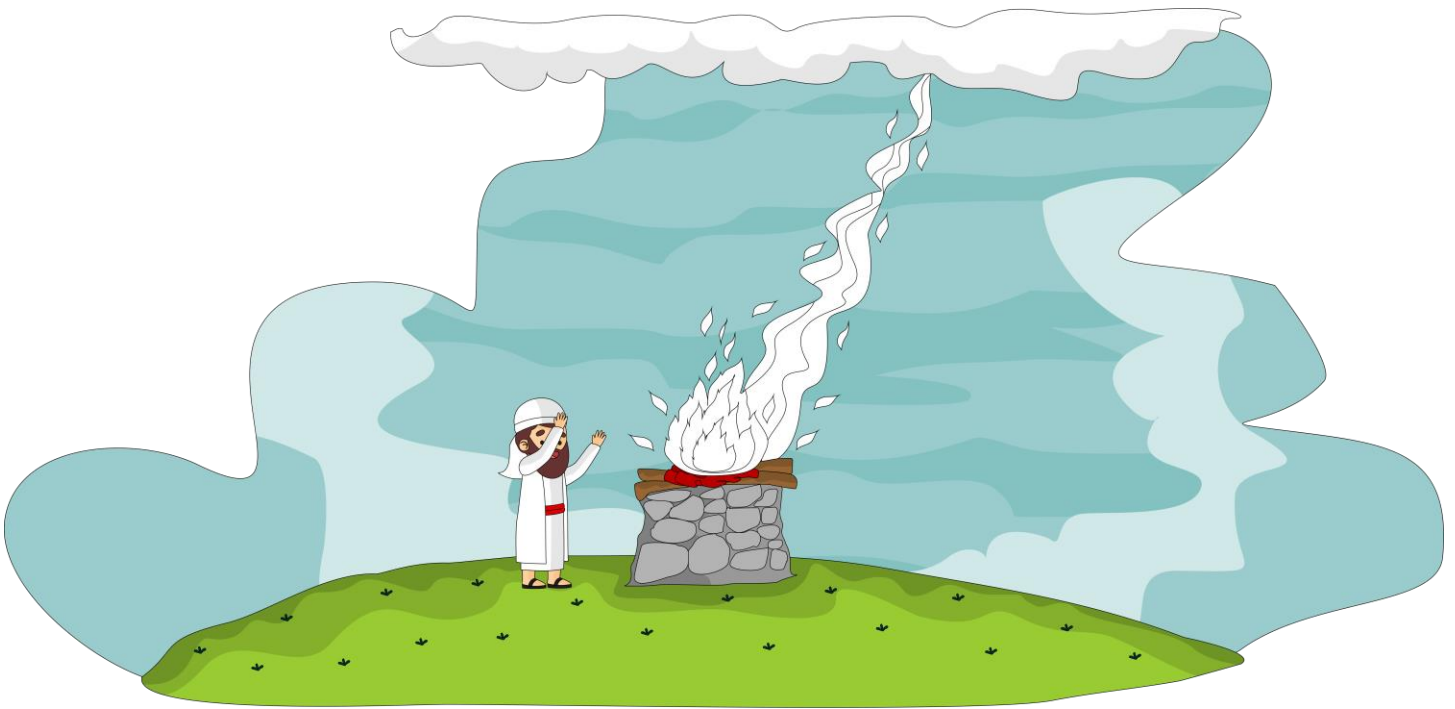

Draw and color in the image below what, according to the biblical passage, descended on the burnt offering.

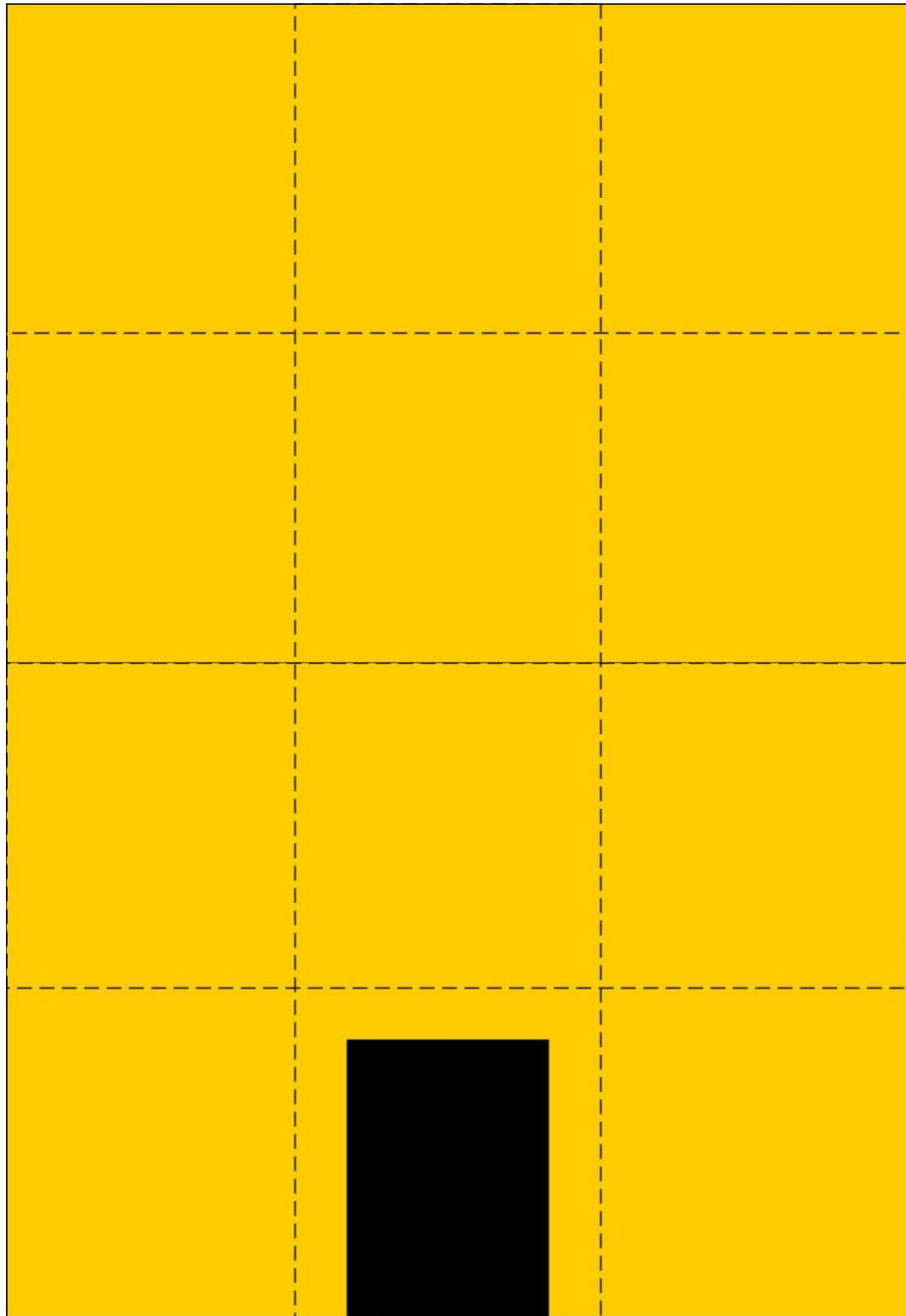


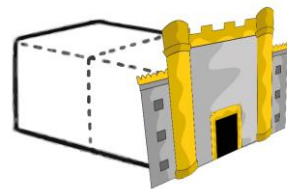
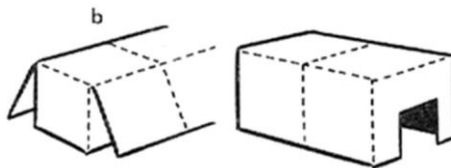
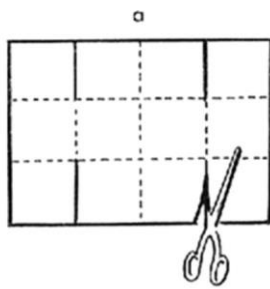
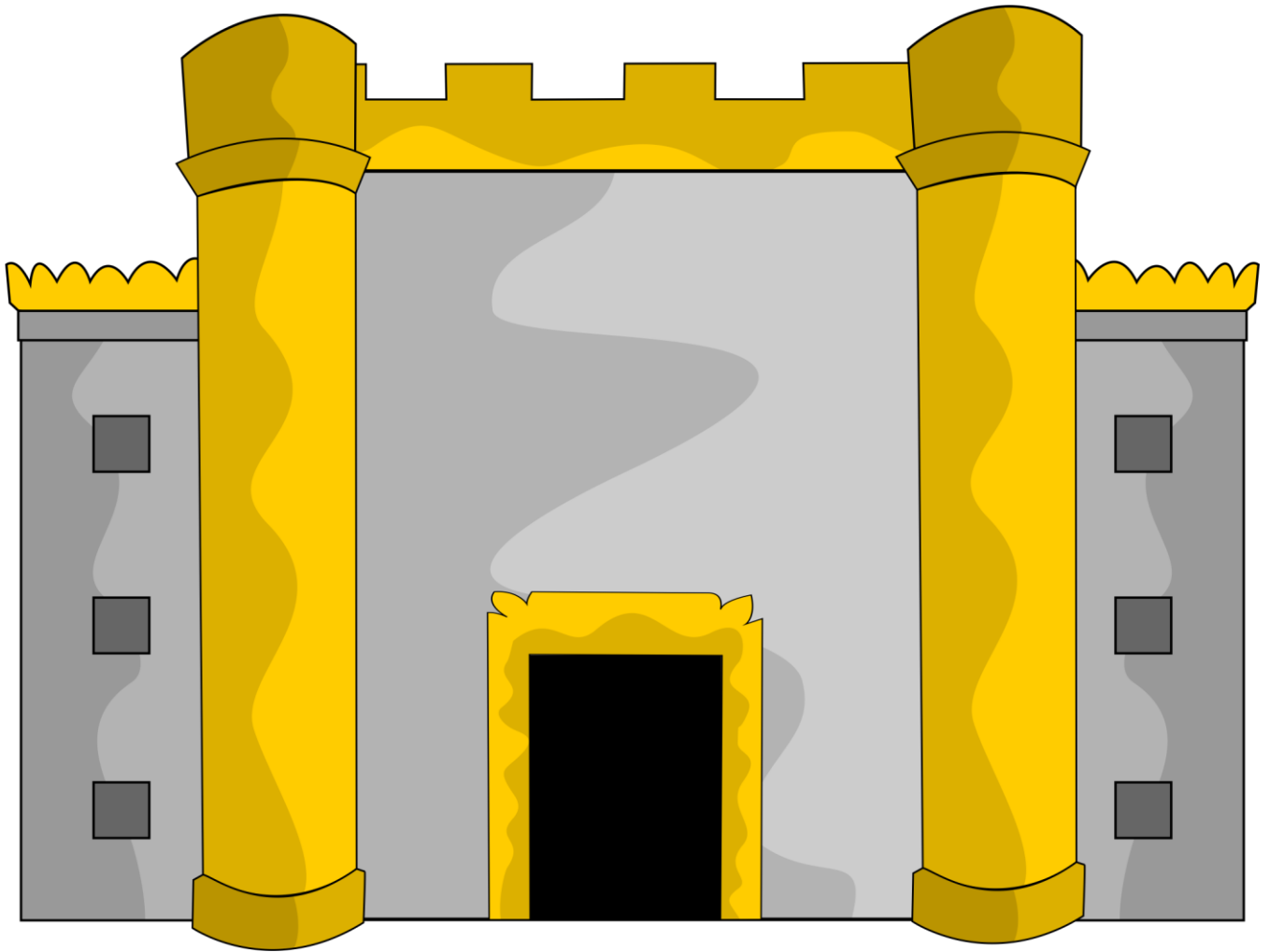
