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


With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures

Solve the code to find out what the second purpose was for Yeshua teaching in parables.






Beit Sefer The Parable of the Wedding Banquet




Teaching:

The Parable of the Unjust Judge

The parable of the unjust judge is also known as the parable of the persistent widow. Read it in Luga (Luke) 18:1-8 and then color the image of the widow pleading with the judge. Then answer: Do you have any prayer request you've stopped asking for?

Finally, the persistent widow got what she asked for.






Teaching:

The Parable of the Mustard Seed

This parable is found in 3 of the 4 gospels. Read Marqaus (Mark) 4:30-32 and then write inside the tree what you can do to grow Yahweh's kingdom. Did you know: The mustard seed measures between 1 and 4 millimeters but as it grows, the mustard tree can measure 7 meters in height and diameter!






Teaching:

The Parable of the Oragnet

Read the parable of the dragnet in **Mattityahu (Matthew) 13:47-50** and then classify the fish with a line according to their characteristics (Good=to the basket; Bad=to the ground). Then answer: **What quality or qualities do you have which you are using for the kingdom of Elohim?**







Answer on the line: Where will the wicked end up according to verse 50?




Teaching:
