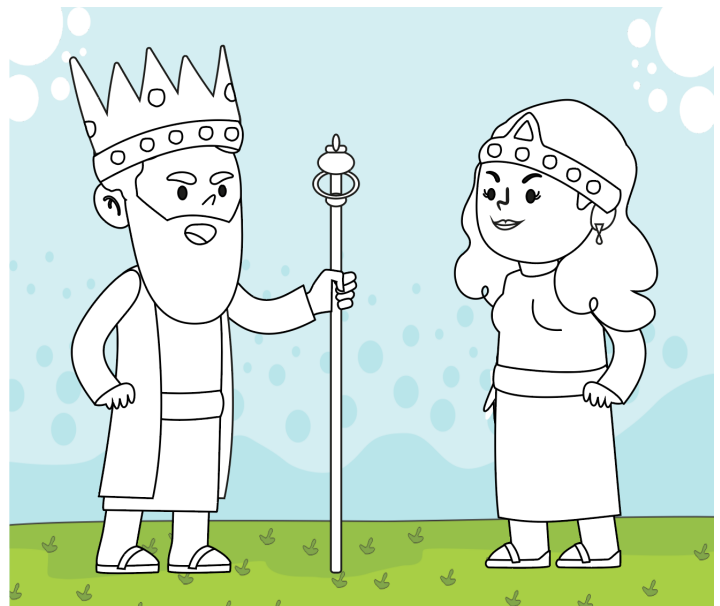
King Ahab did what was good before Yahweh, keeping all His commandments.
