


With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures

With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures Melachim Bet (2 Kings) 5:1-14

The story of the miracle of the healing of Naaman's leprosy leaves us with two very important lessons. The first is that we must **testify** of Yahweh's love and power to people as did the servant girl of Naaman's wife and the second is that we must **remove** pride from our lives if we want Yahweh to heal our souls and bodies, just as Naaman did in the end.

YAHWEH'S POWER GOES BEYOND NATURAL LAWS!




