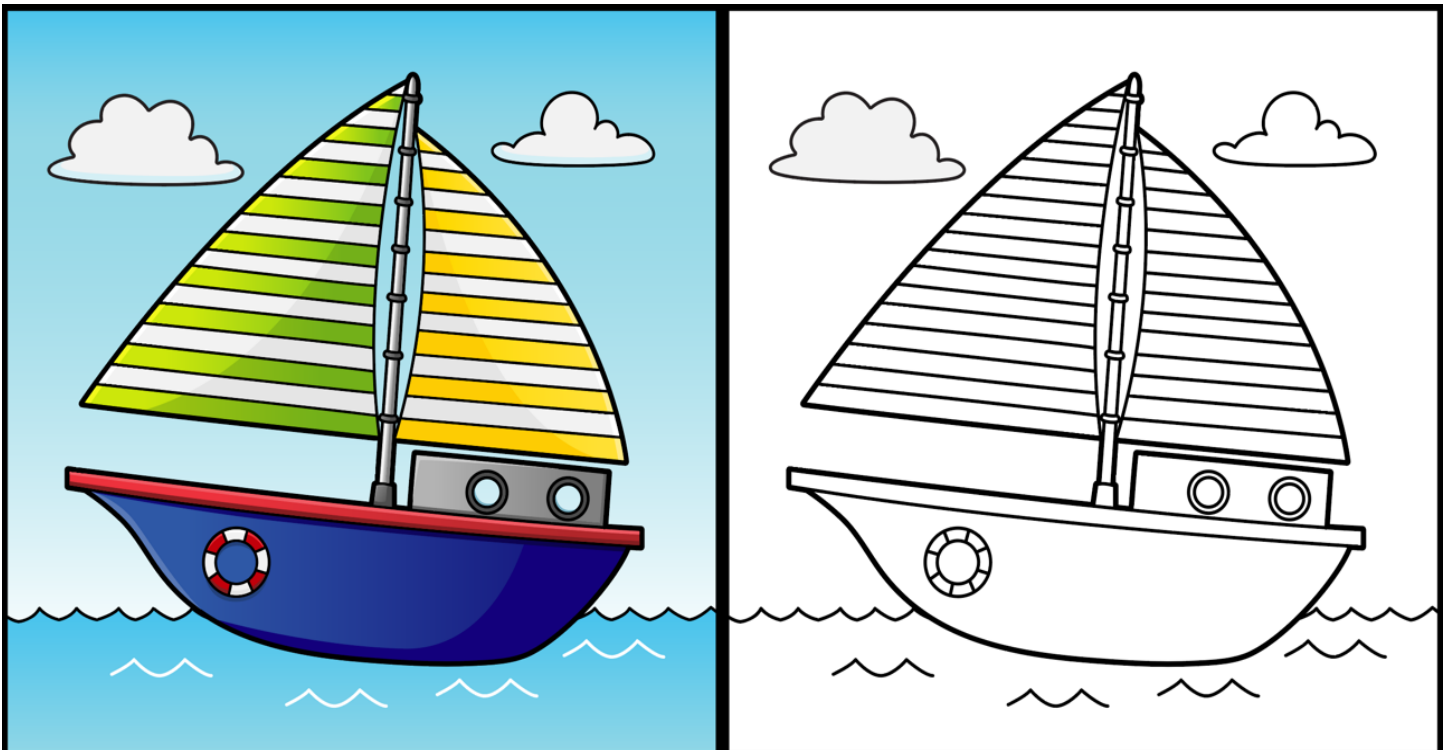




With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures

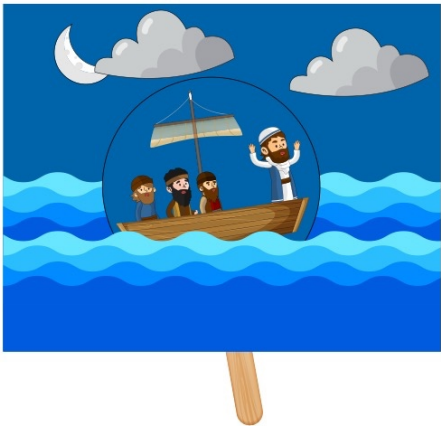
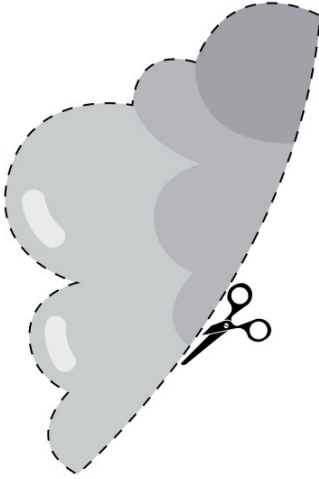

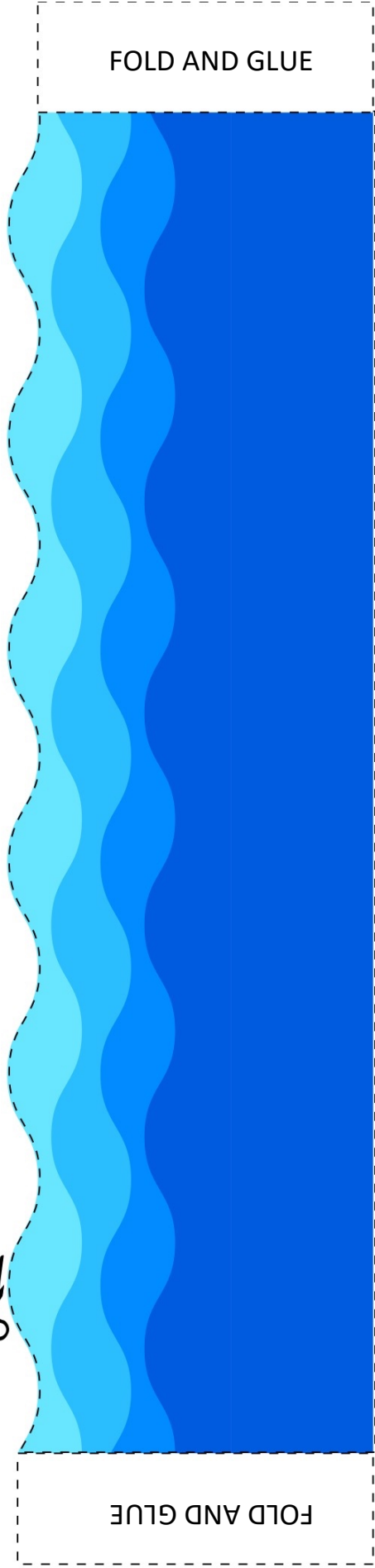


In summary, the story of Yeshua calming the storm reminds us that we can trust Him in the midst of difficulties, that He has power over all things and that our faith must be active and persevering.

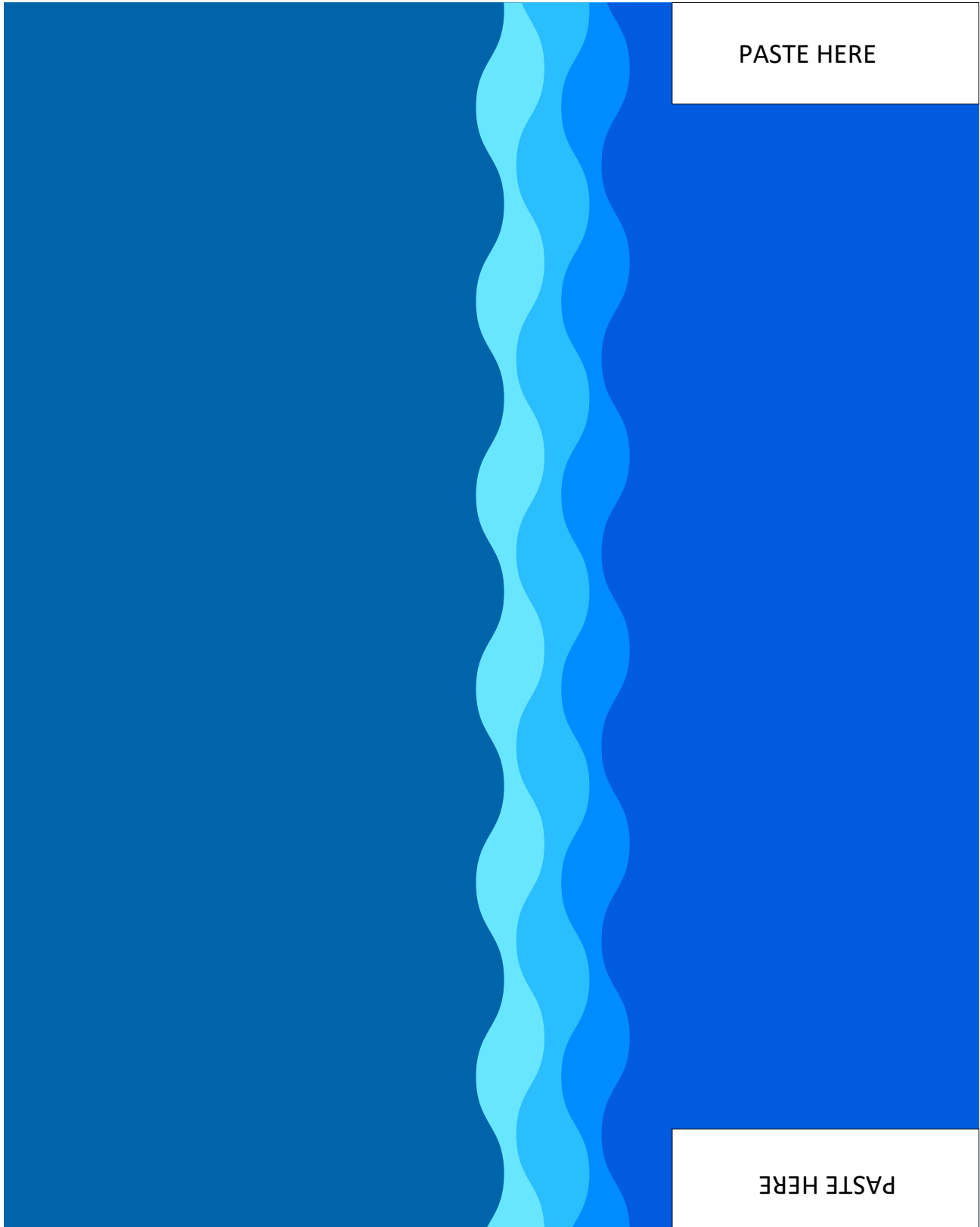
