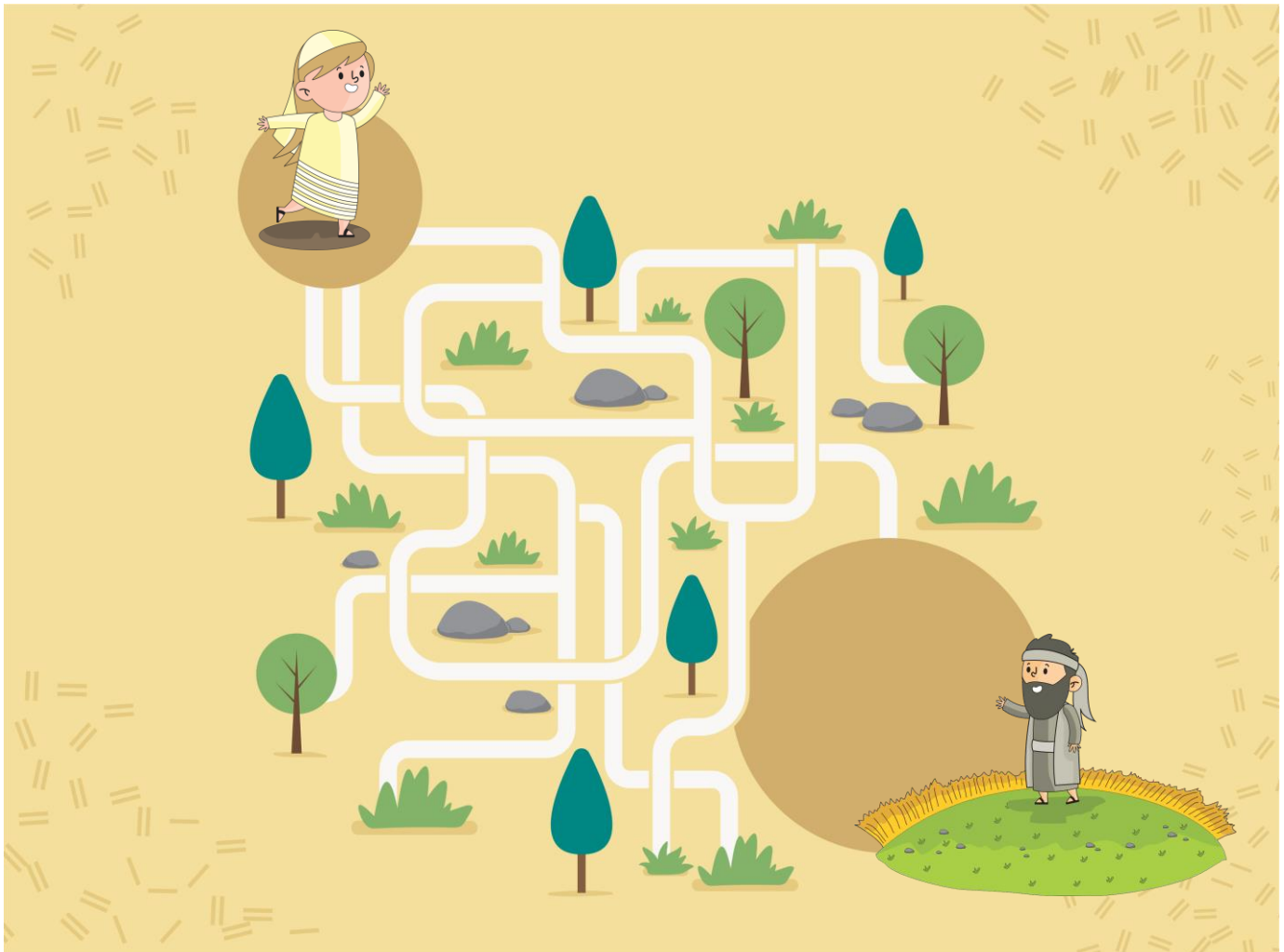




With the help of an adult, read from the Scriptures.

Help Ruth find Boaz.



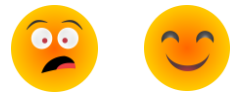

Circle all the clothes and oils so that Ruth can be ready to meet Boaz.

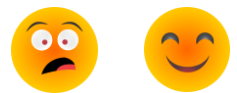

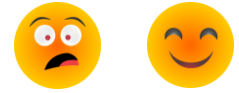
So he went down to the threshing floor and did not do as his mother-in-law had told him. **Rut (Ruth) 3:6**

Rut (Ruth) 3:9



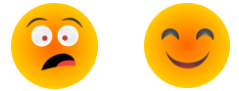
And now, my daughter, do not fear. I will do for you all that you request, for all the people of my town know that you are a widow woman. **Rut (Ruth) 3:11**

Spend the night here, and when it is day, if he will redeem you, well, redeem yourself; but if he will not redeem you, neither will I redeem you, as Yahweh lives. So rest until the morning. **Rut (Ruth) 3:13**

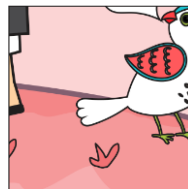
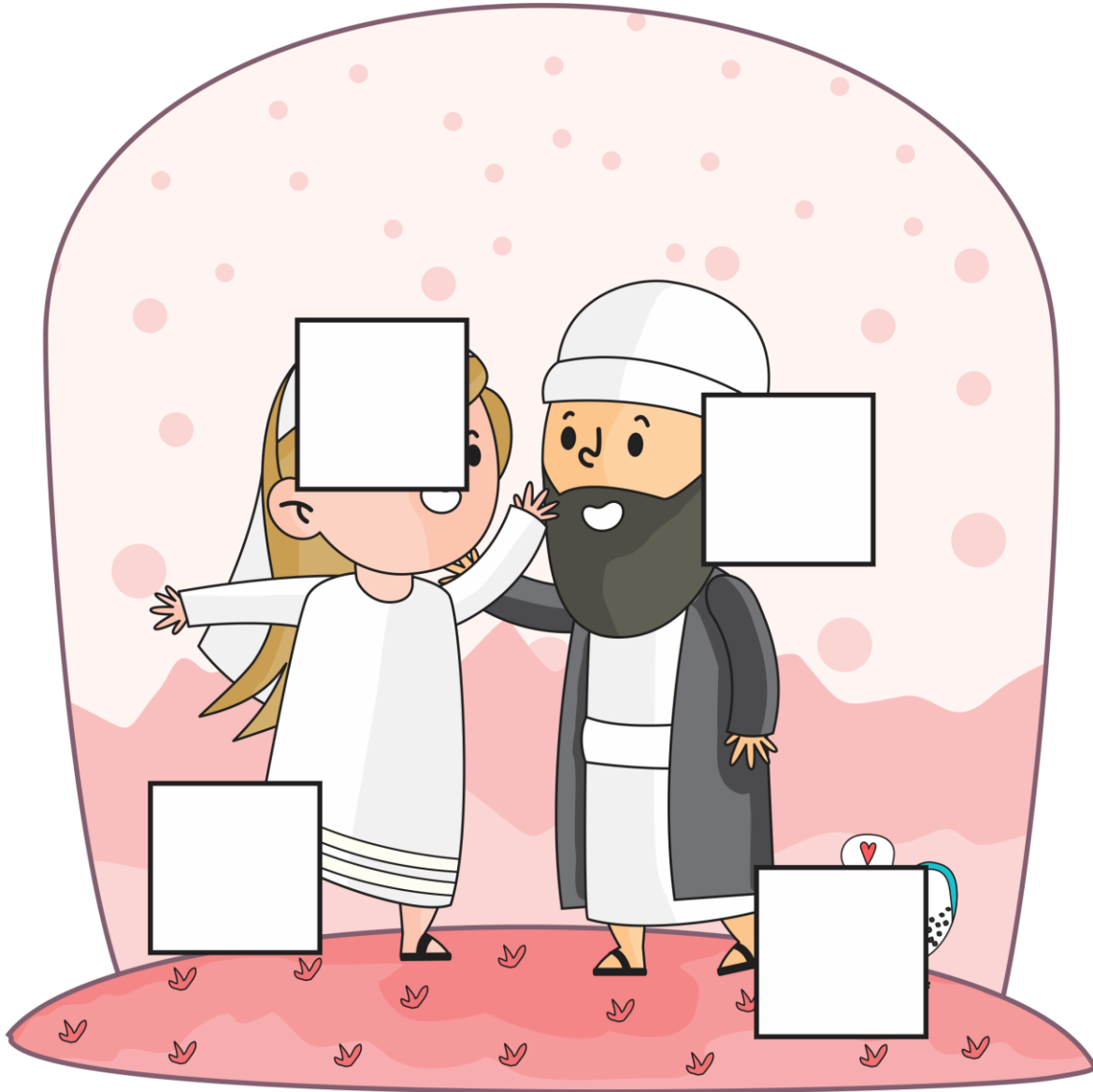
