



## Firstfruits and tithes



With the help of an adult read **Deuteronomy (Devarim) 26** in the Scriptures

Both the first fruits and the tithe are commandments given by Yahweh, through them He teaches us to be faithful and to trust in Him.

Let's look at some differences between first fruits and tithe.

### Firstfruits

It is not a fixed amount.

It is an offering.

It is a contribution.

It is occasional.

### TITHE

It is the tenth part.

It is a payment.

It is a tax.

It is permanent.

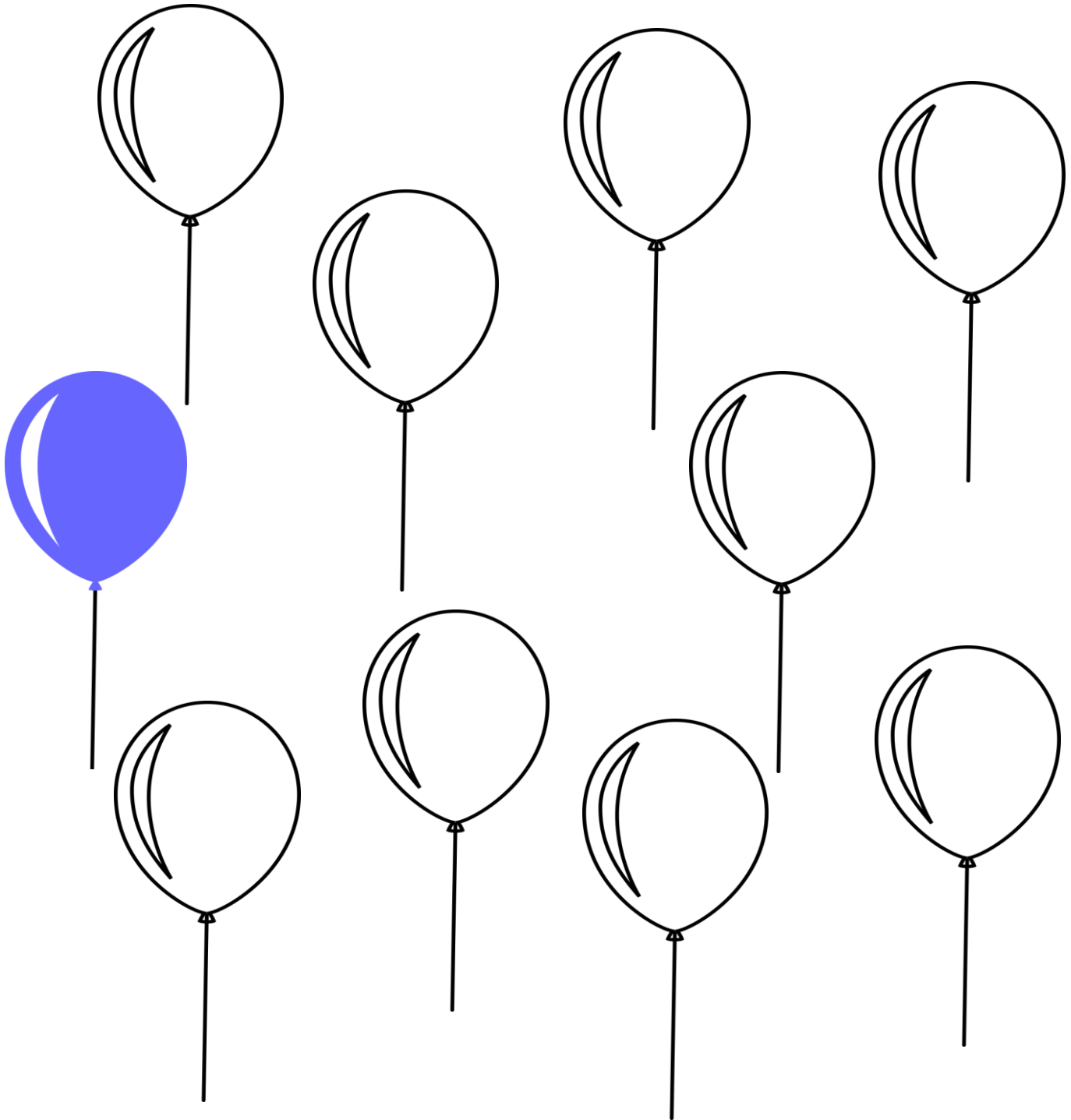
The tithe is the tenth part of the income received (10%), while the first fruits are the first fruits of our labor. In actuality, it refers to the first income or production received. Both are dedicated to Elohim.



Tithing is giving back to our Creator a tenth of all that He gives us.

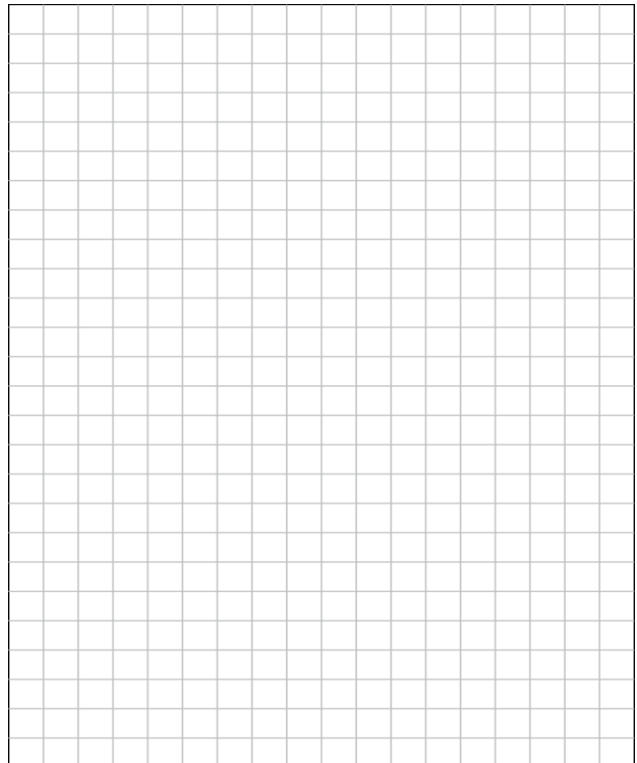
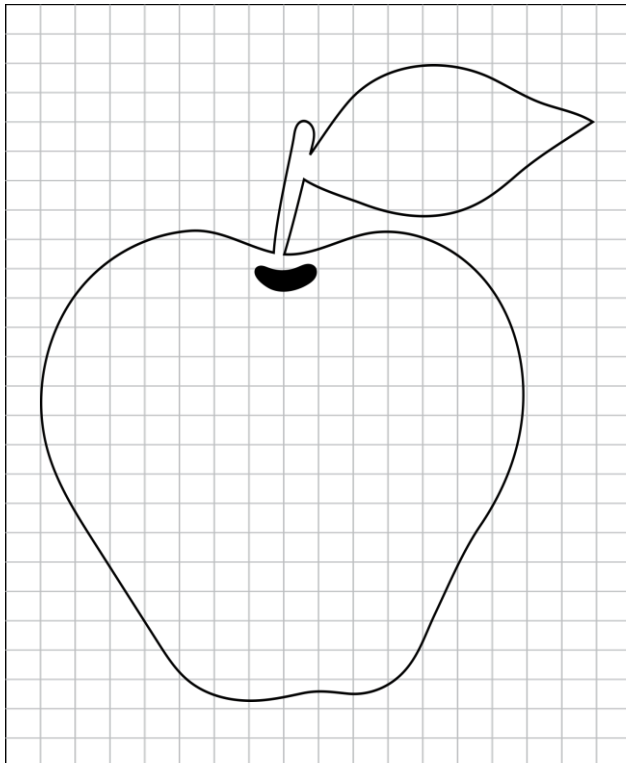
