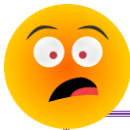

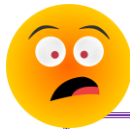
Circle the smiley face if the sentence is correct or the surprised face if it is false.

Yahweh was very displeased that they spoke behind his servant's back.

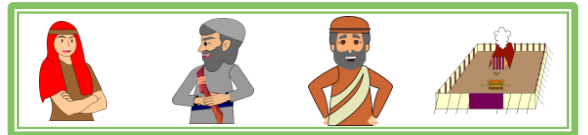
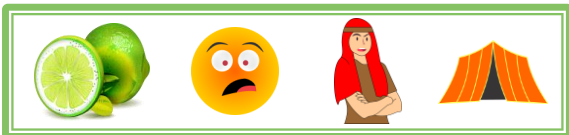


The people of Israel kept on walking and after the 7 days Miriam had to catch up with them at Hazeroth.
