



With the help of an adult, read from the Scriptures Numbers (Bamidbar) 13


The land that Yahweh promised Israel was a very fertile land.

The other spies said that they were like locusts among the inhabitants of that land.






The spies returned from spy on the land at the end of 40 days.






Help the spies to reach the camp quickly.
