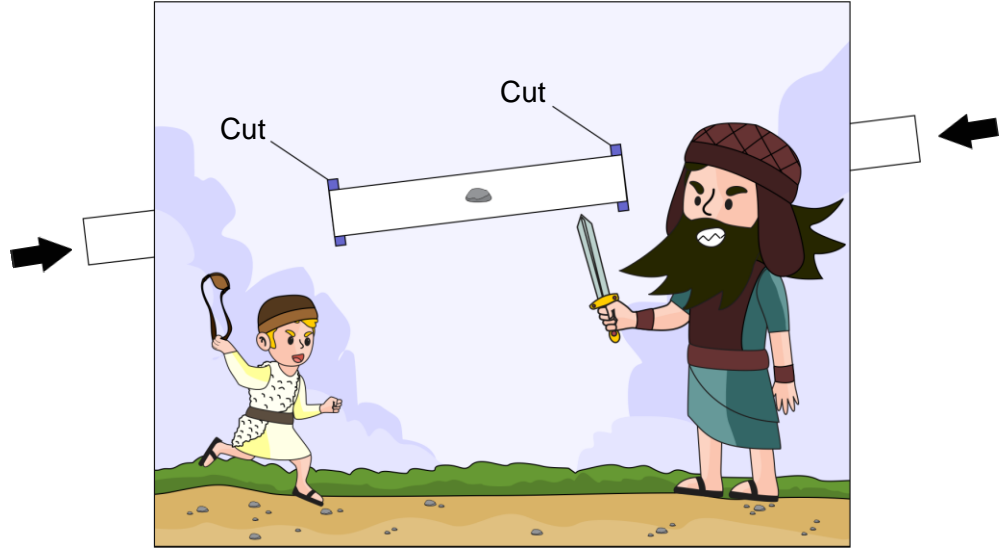
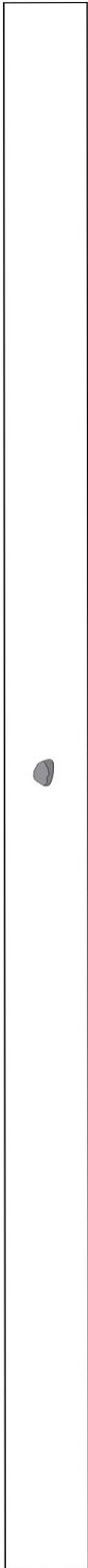
- Read 1 Samuel 17:50
