- King Shaul sent for David to kill him, for he said to Jonathan, "Neither you shall stand firm, nor your kingdom."
- The next day Jonathan rode out into the field on horseback to tell David of his father's plans.
- David and Jonathan took their leave in tears, saying, "Yahweh be between me and you, between your offspring and mine."
