With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures Exodus (Shemot) 28




Look closely at Aaron the priest and the garments of honor given to him by Yahweh, then find and encircle the silhouette that corresponds to him.

The names of the children of Israel were to be engraved in any order.


























Find and circle the repeated image in each set.
