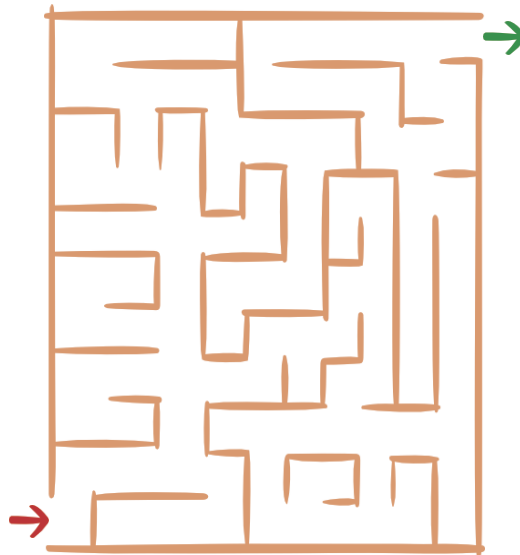
Gath

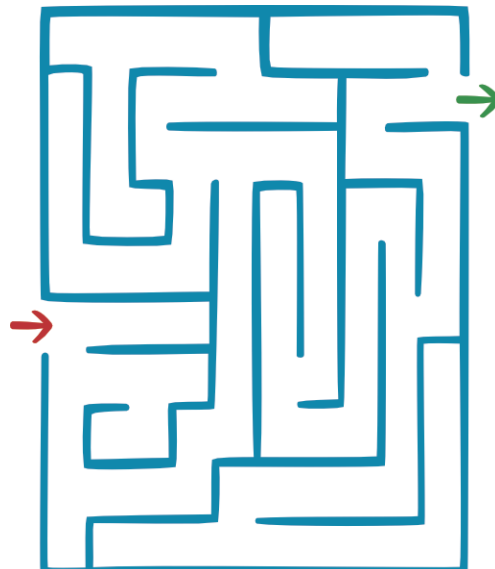
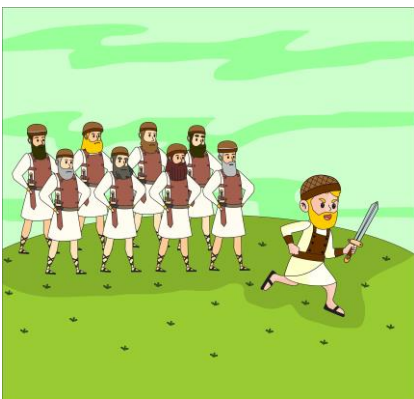

In this chapter we will see the terrible sin committed by King Shaul that cost him his life later on. It is the sin of divination.

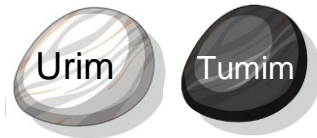
Divination: A fact that is known without using procedures based on reason or scientific knowledge but by means of magic, interpretation of signs of nature. etc.

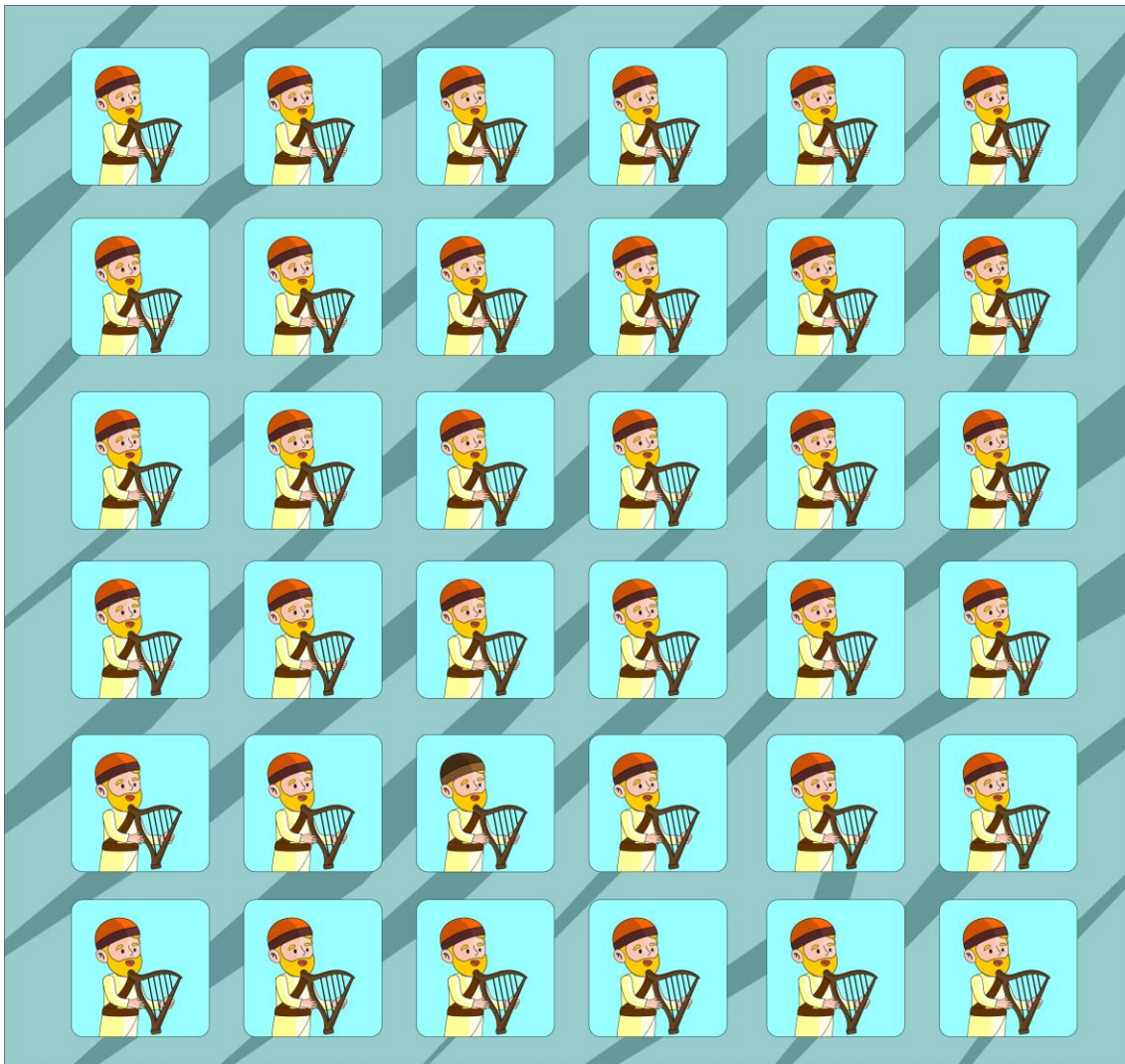

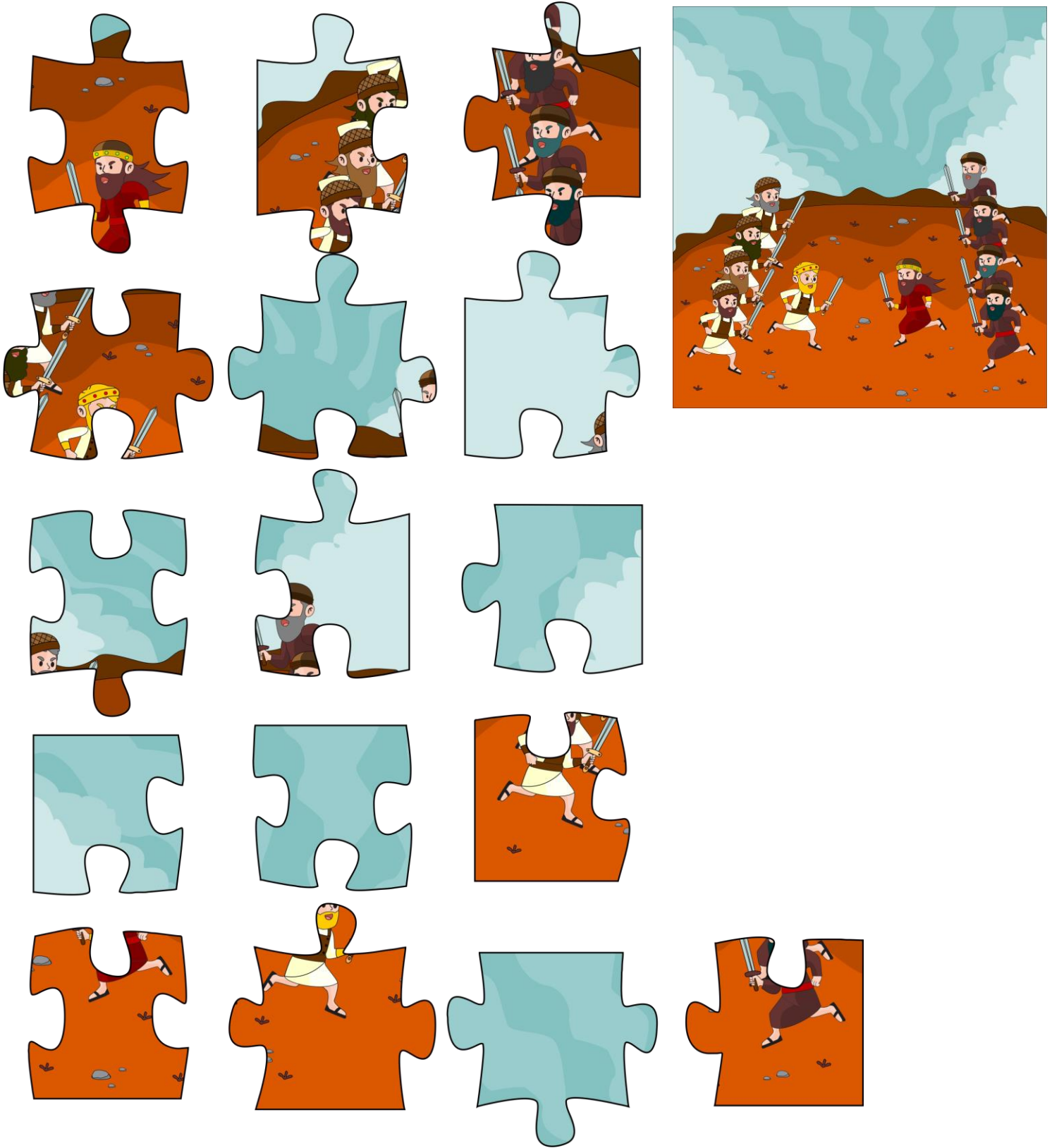
In this chapter we see that the princes of the Philistines knew that David was different from the others and that sooner or later he would end up serving the Elohim of Israel (which he was always doing in secret).
