

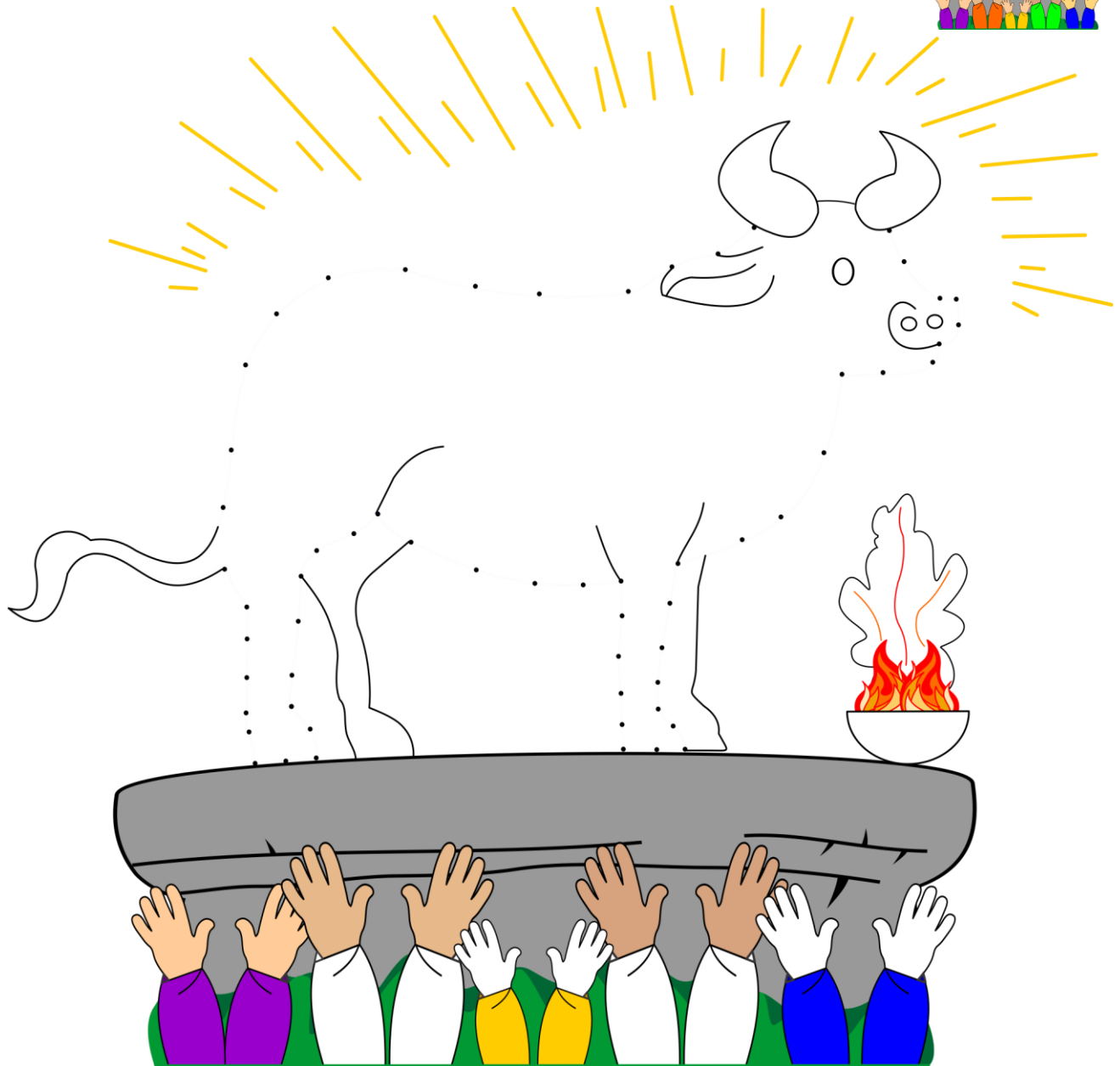
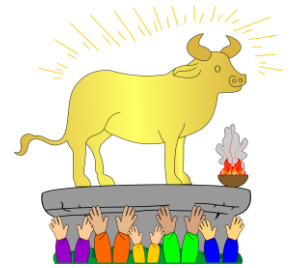


The golden calf



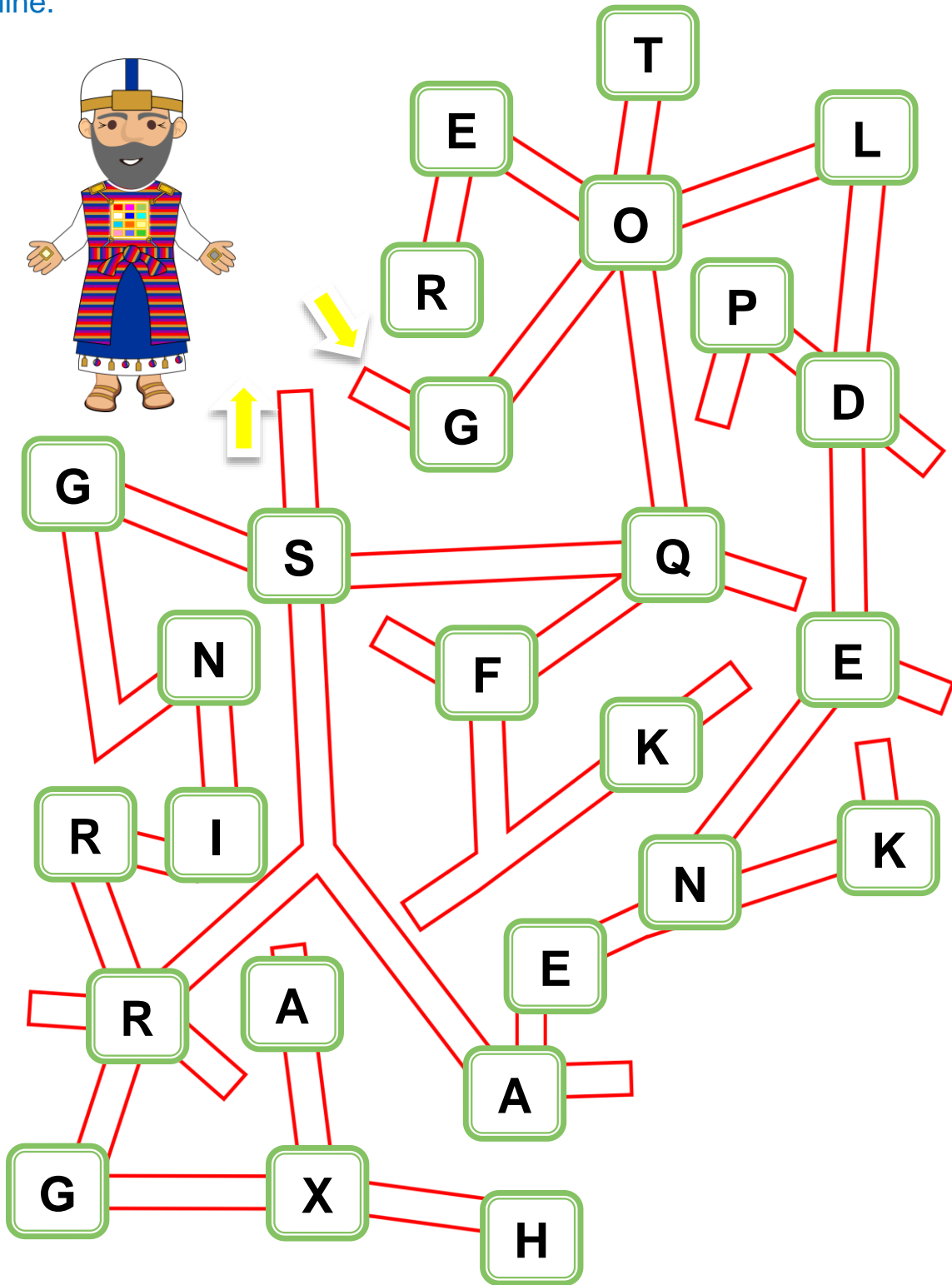
With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures **Exodus (Shemot) 32**

Very few Israelites wore their golden earrings for the making of the calf.



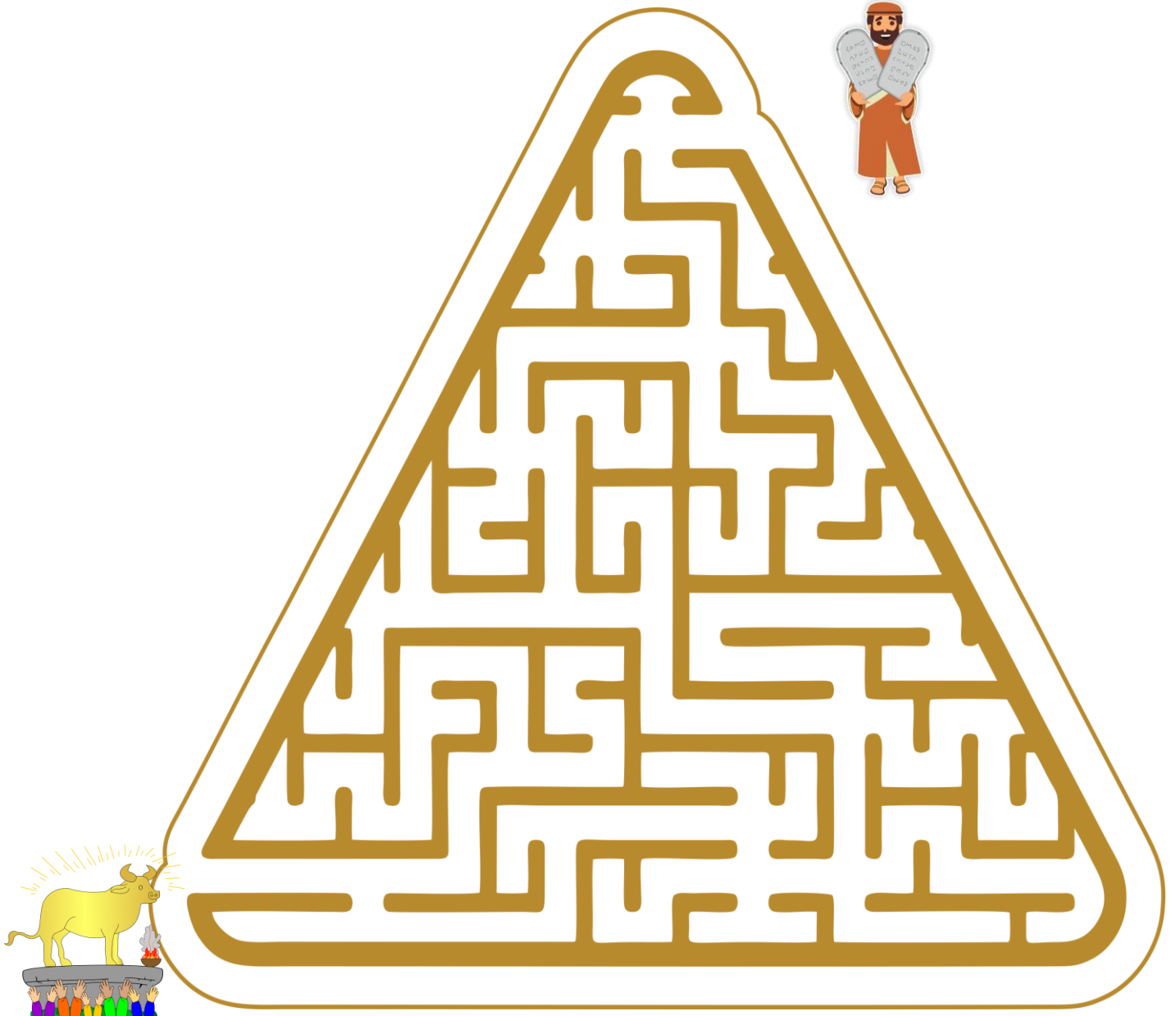
Aaron proclaimed a feast in honor of the god he created.
