

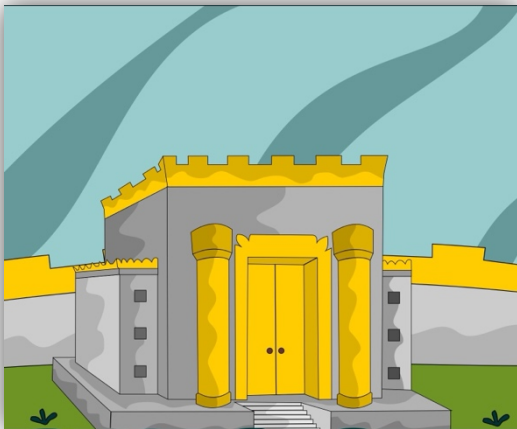
# THE REIGN OF JEROBOAM

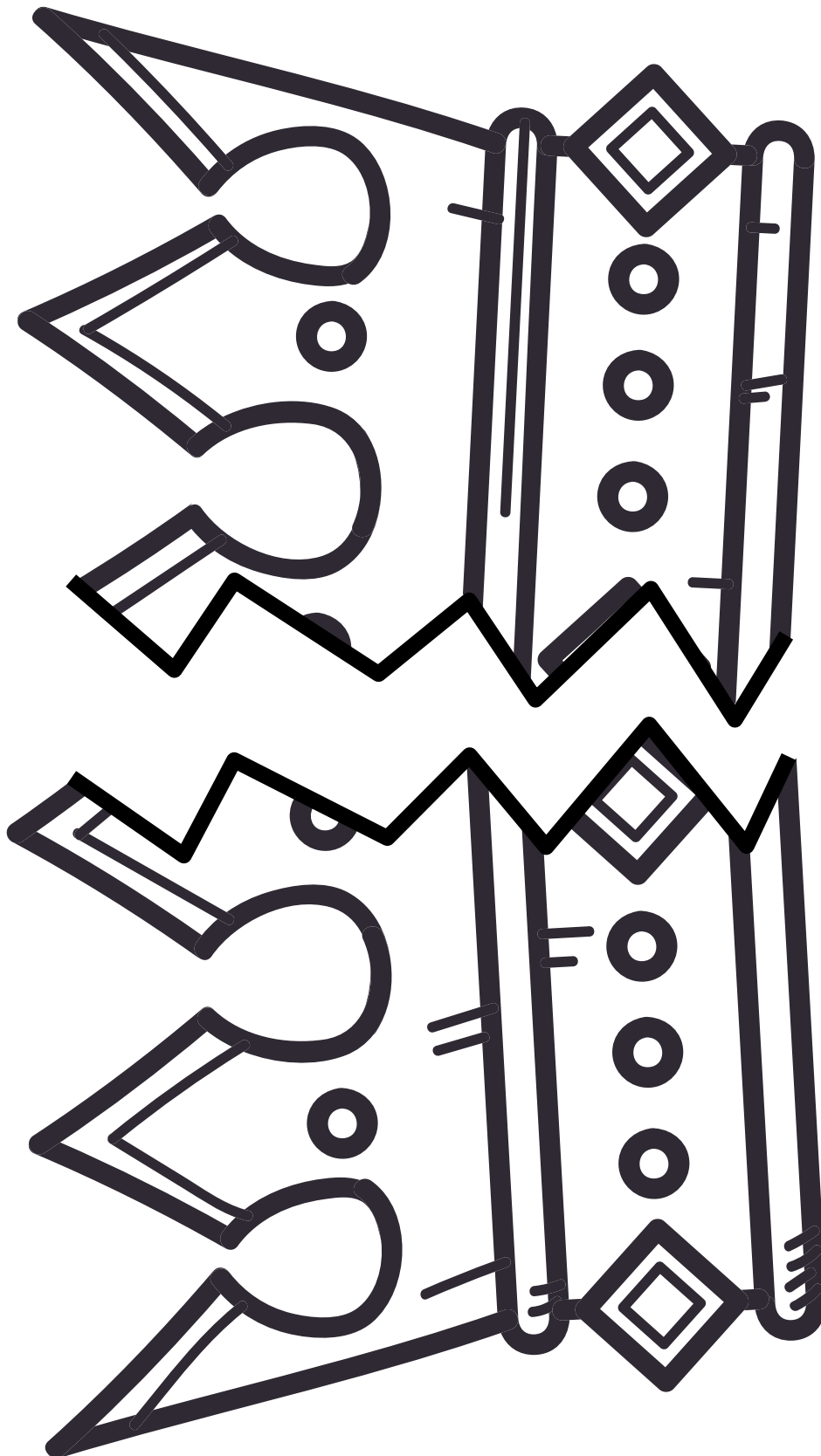
