... was the son of King Ahaziah and was 7 years old.

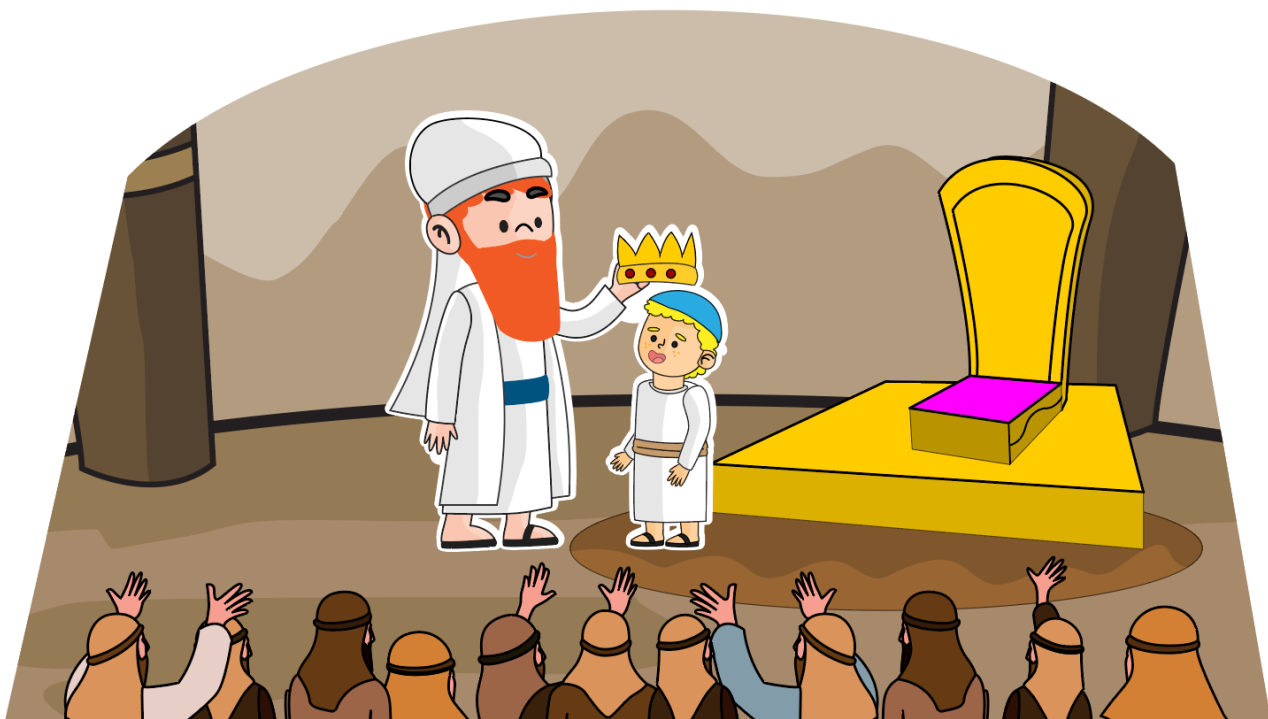
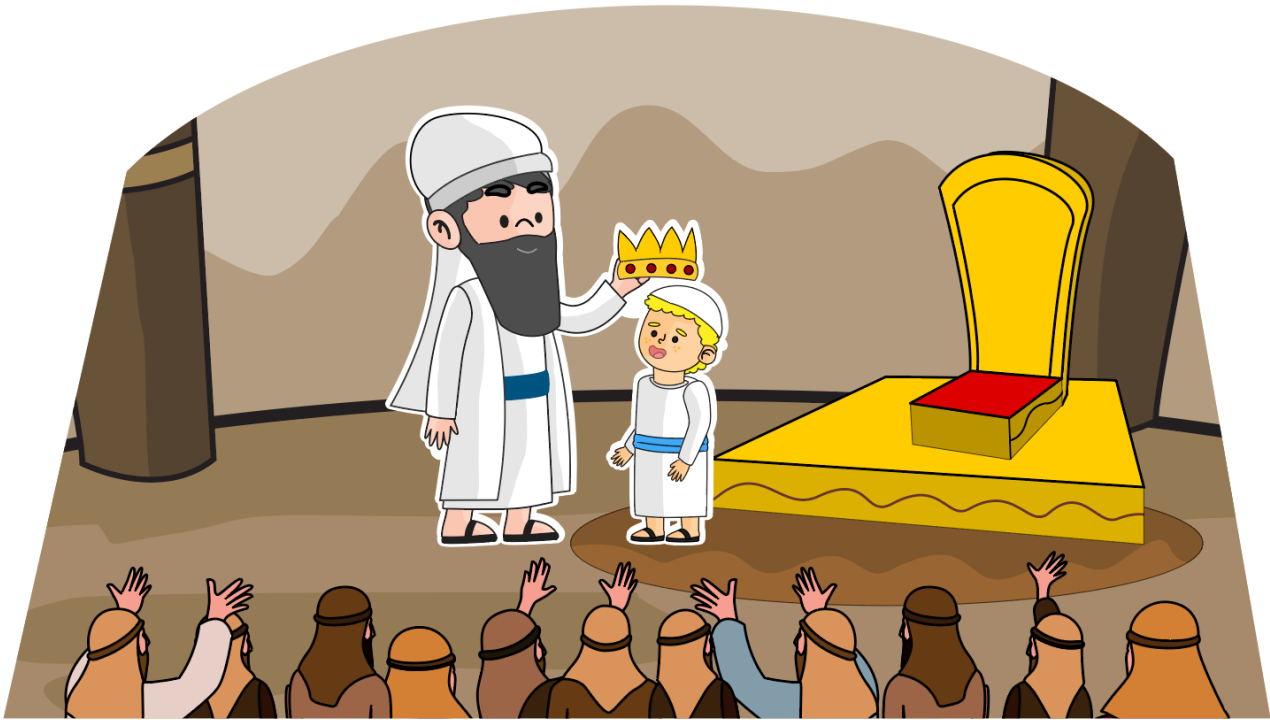

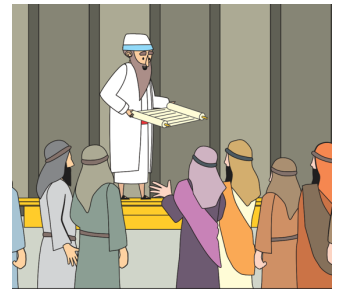

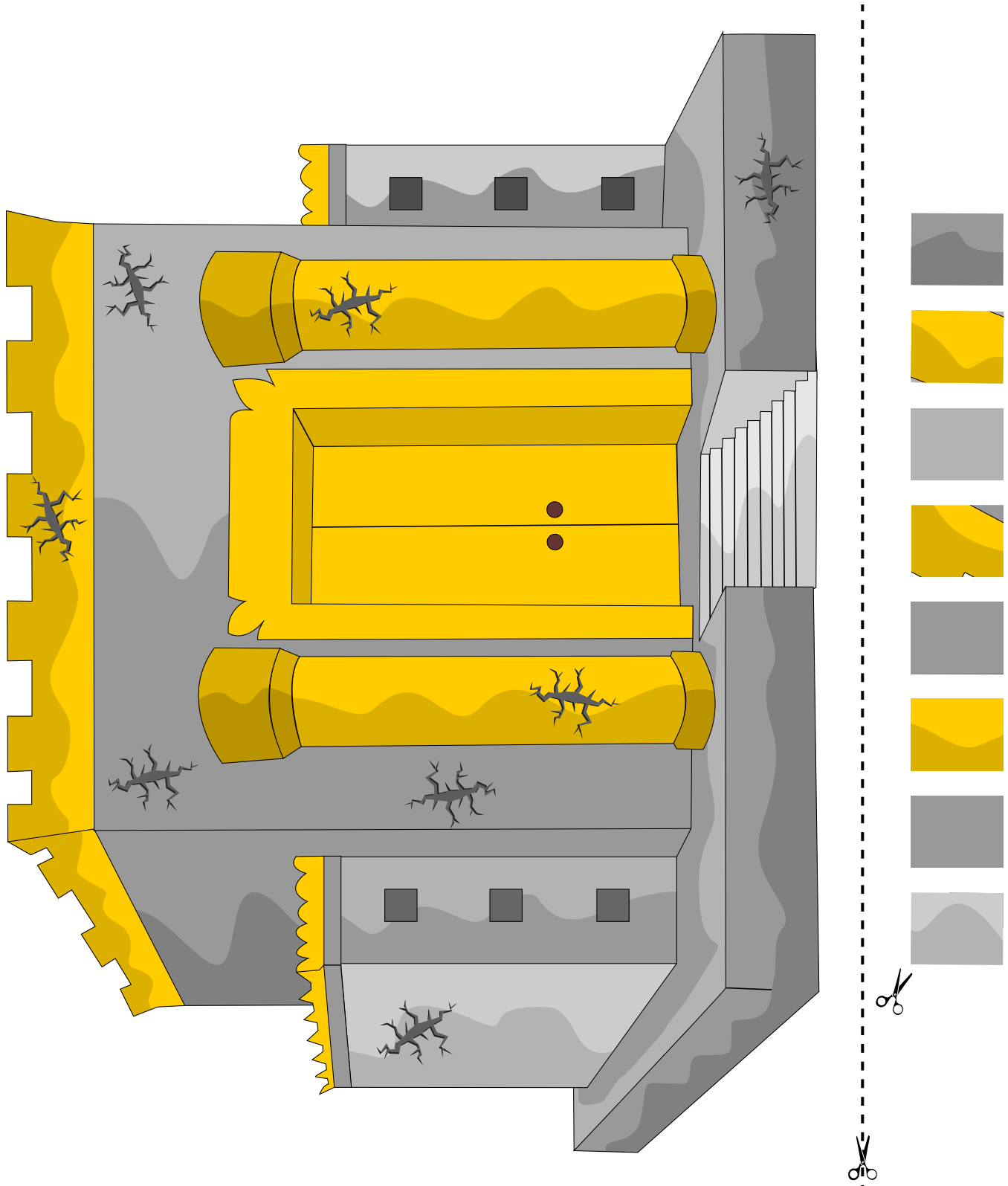
