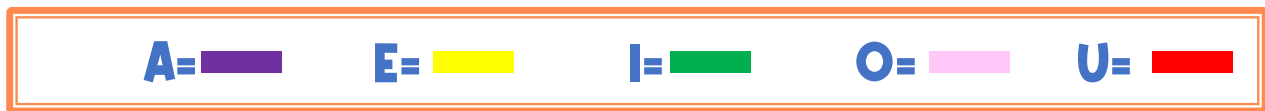
A light of hope in the midst of darkness!

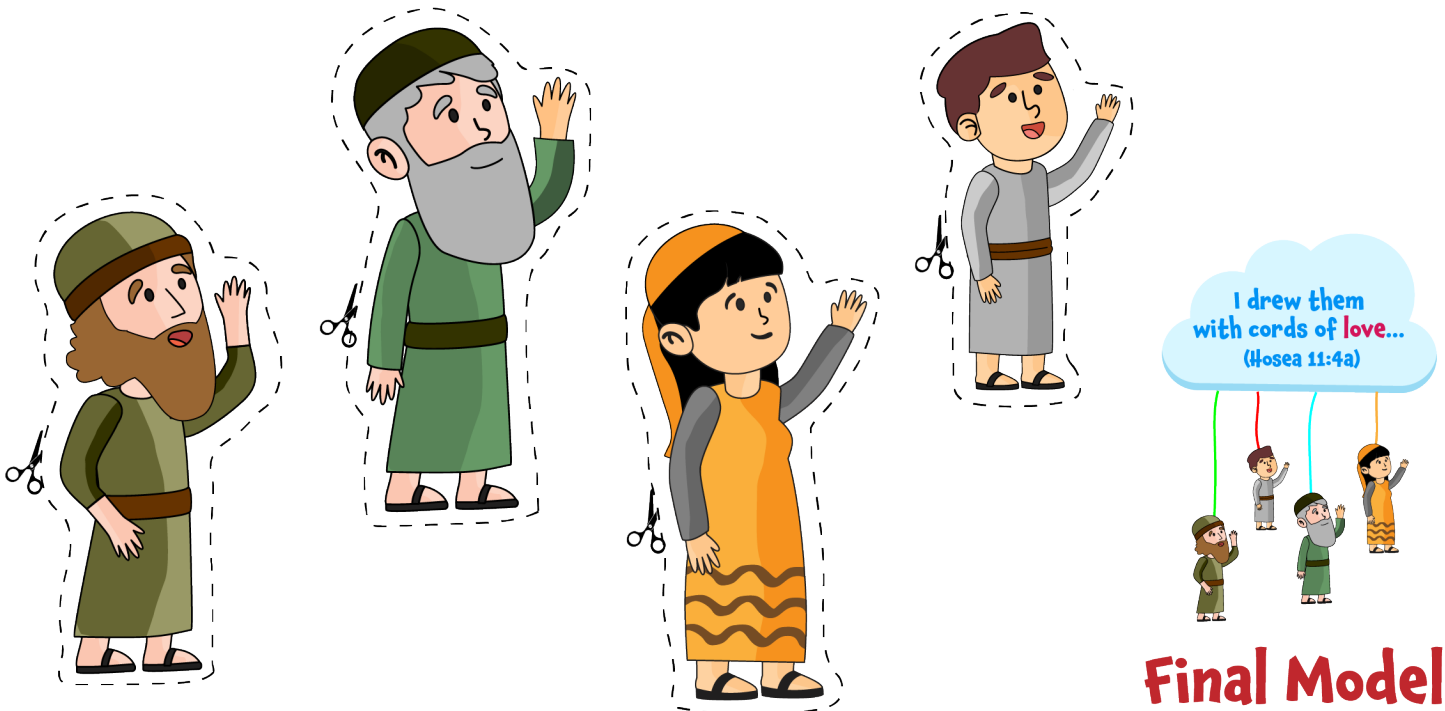
