Melachim Bet (2 Kings) 17:1-4

Next we will study an important lesson that marks the end of the northern reign or kingdom of Israel. The reign of Hosea, king of Israel, would be the last after the coming of the king of Assyria.

...for they served idols, of which Yahweh had said to them, "You shall NOT do this thing." (Melachim Bet 17:12)




As verse 17:13 says, Yahweh sent prophets and seers to turn the people of Israel from their sins, to repent and keep the commandments and ordinances.

Follow the code and fill in the missing letters with vowels and read this verse aloud.


