But the man who touches them Must be armed with iron and the shaft of a spear, And they shall be utterly burned with fire in their place.















Help Joab and count how many of Israel and how many of Judah you see in the picture. Write the result in the box. Then answer the questions.




Draw and color in the box what King David had to do, on the advice of the prophet Gad, so that Yahweh would stop the plague and mortality that was occurring in Israel.
