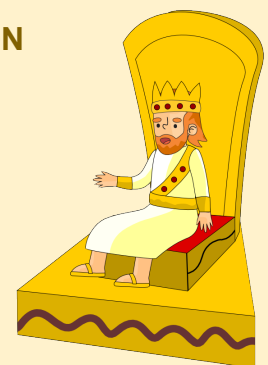

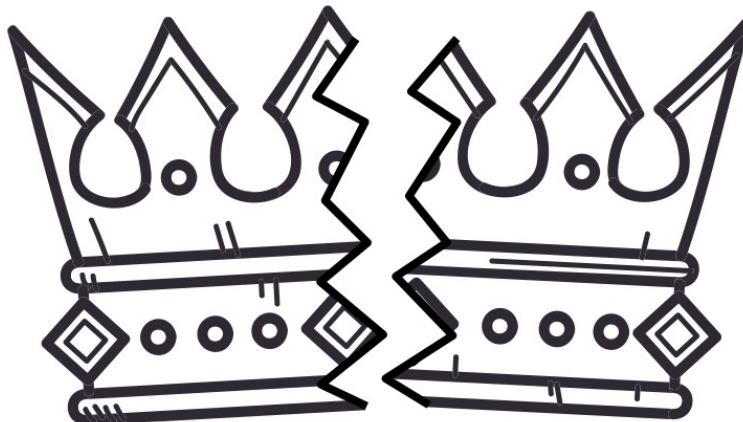

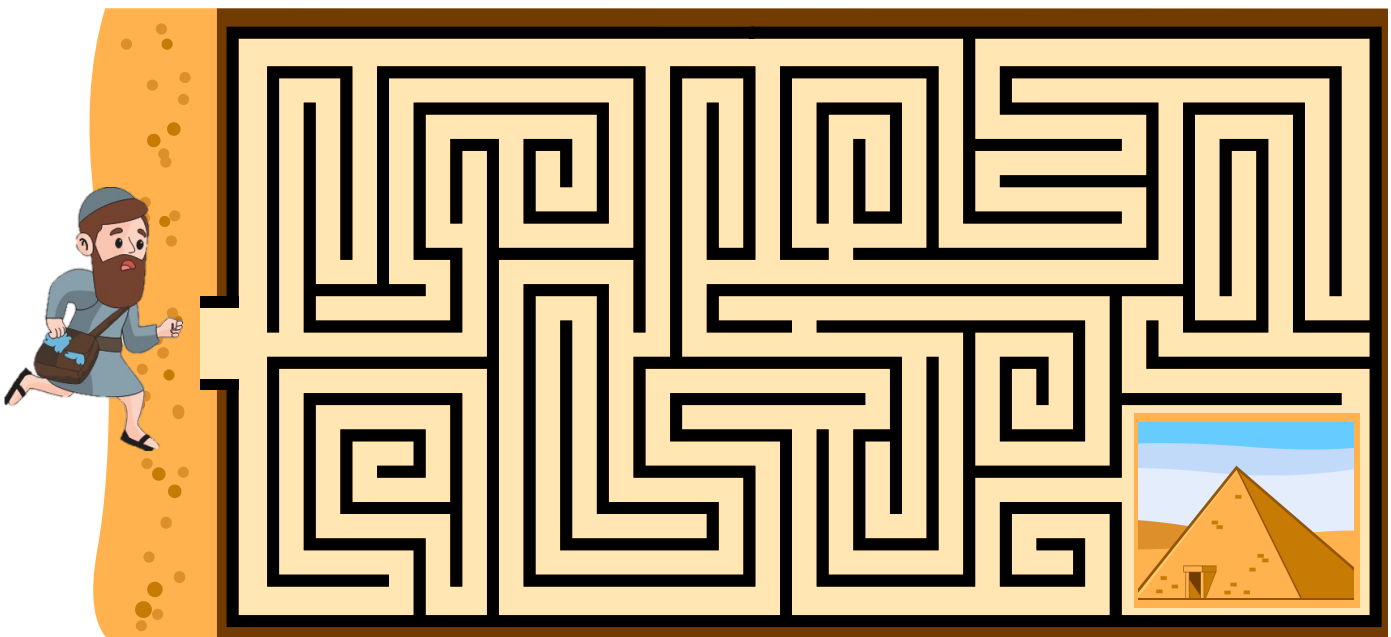
Color each piece of the divided crown a different color.

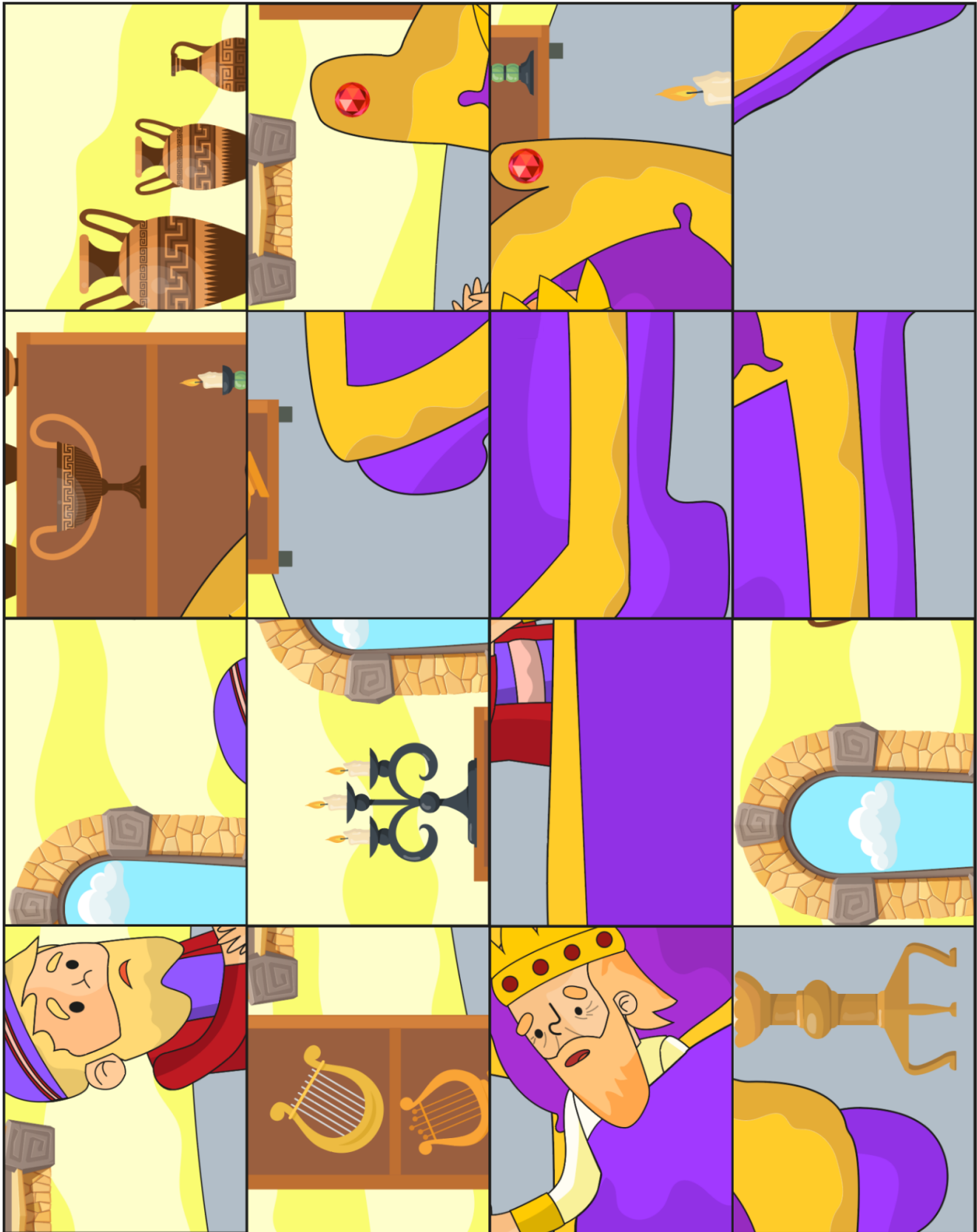
