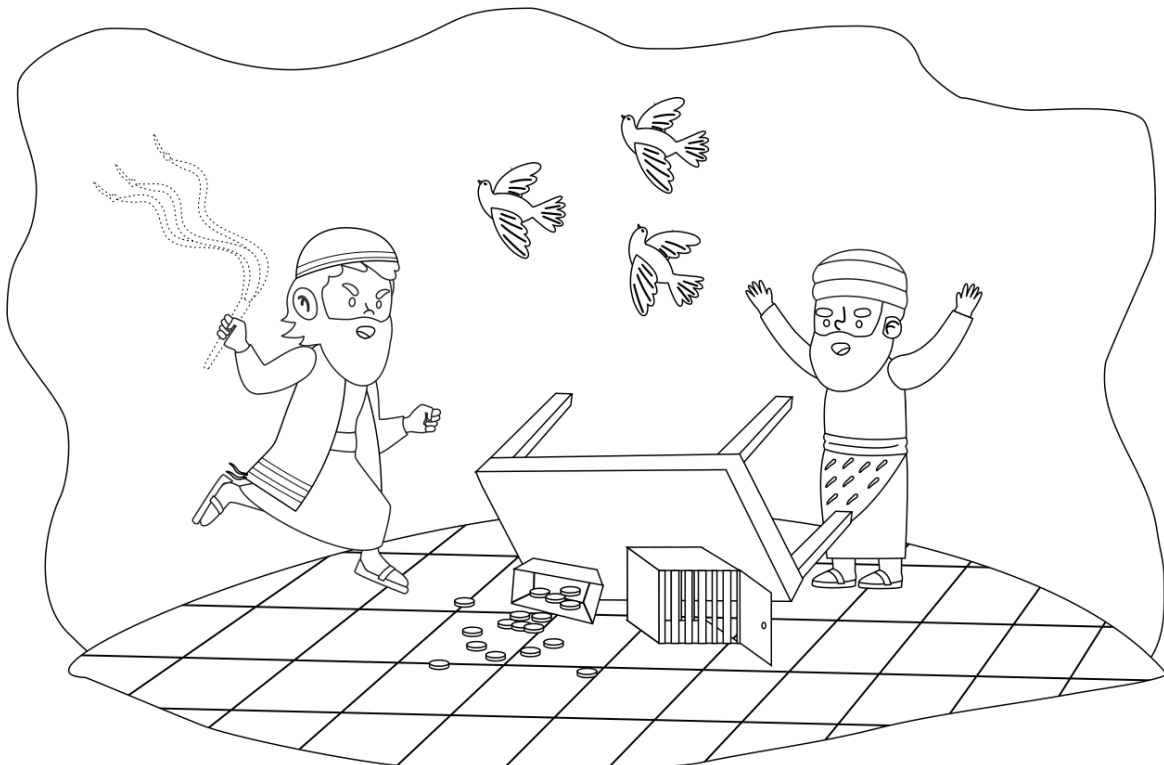




With the help of an adult read from the Scriptures

The Bible says that Nicodemus was a Pharisee, chief among the Jews. He came by night to see Yeshua to talk and resolve some doubts. Also, in this passage,

Yeshua speaks of Yahweh's great love for us. **Connect the question with the answer Yeshua gives to Nicodemus.**

How can a man be born old?

He comes to the light, that his deeds may be seen and give glory to Elohim.

What does someone born of the Spirit look like?

He has already been condemned for not believing.

How is it necessary for the Son of Man to be lifted up?

Just as the serpent in the wilderness was lifted up by Moshe (Moses).

Why did Elohim send His Son into the world?

Born of water and the Spirit, or he cannot enter the kingdom of Elohim.

What happens to the one who does not believe in the Son of Elohim?

That the world might be saved by Him.

What does he who practices the truth do?

It's like the wind when it blows, you don't know where it's coming from or where it's going.

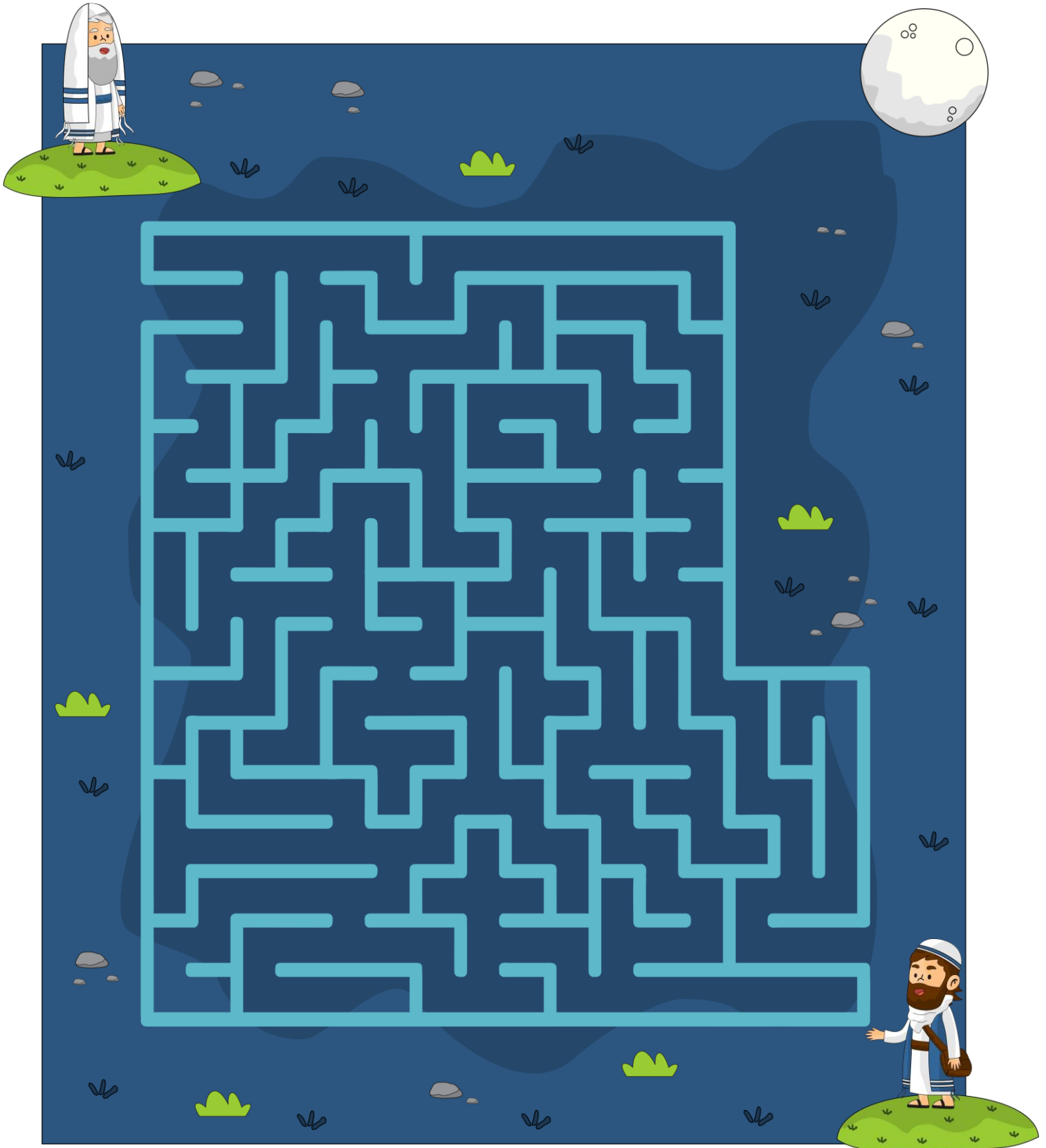

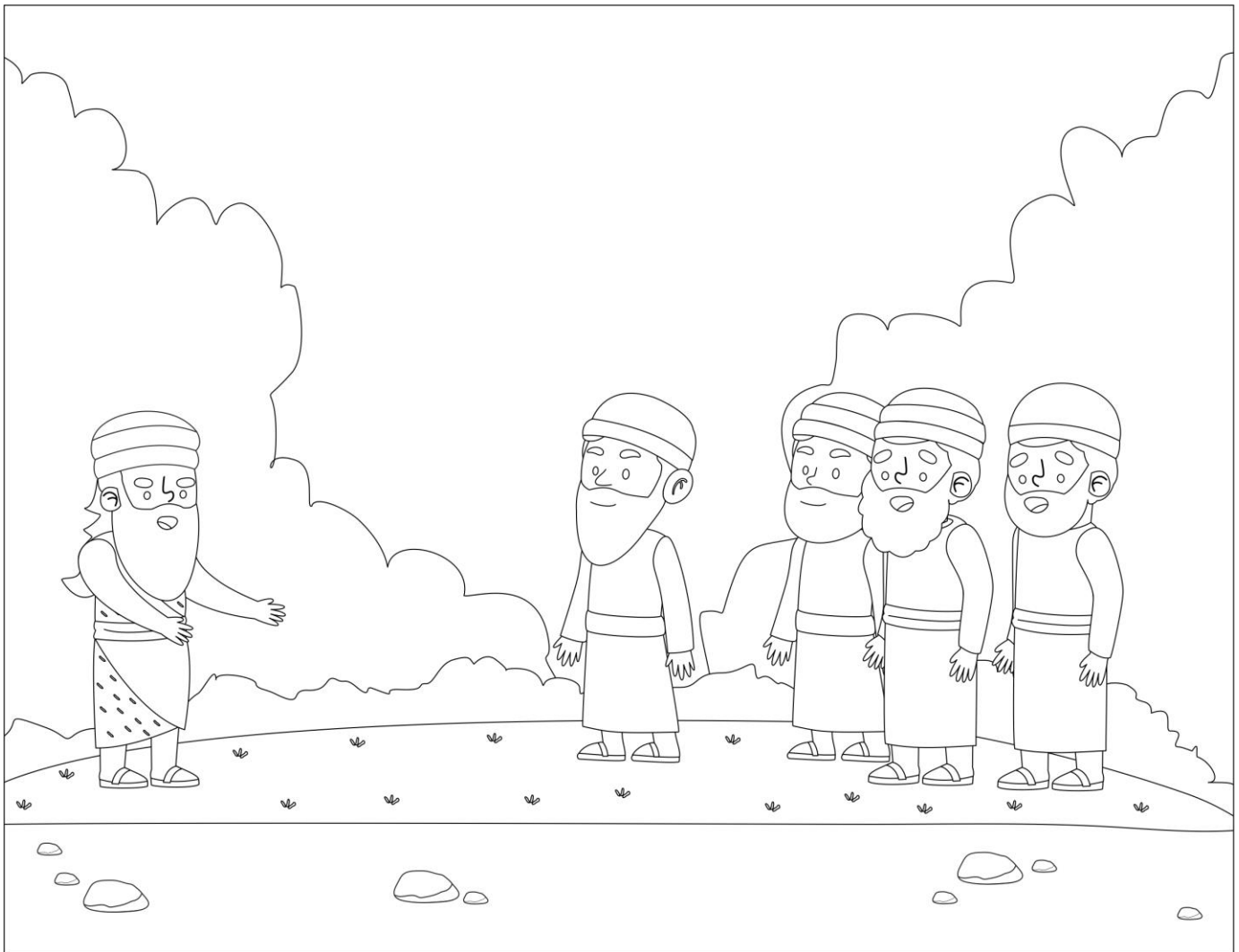
Help Nicodemus get to Yeshua and not get lost during the night.

Yochanan (John) 3:22-36

In this passage, we see that Yochanan continued with his work of straightening the paths, immersing (baptizing) for repentance and preparing the way for Yeshua's message and plan. He did **not compete with Yeshua** but recognized that the Messiah must increase and he must decrease. In Luqa 3:19-20, we can see that, shortly thereafter, Yochanan the immerser was arrested by Herod and taken to prison. **We learn here that Yochanan fulfilled his mission to the end, even while in prison he was faithful to the call that Yahweh gave him.**

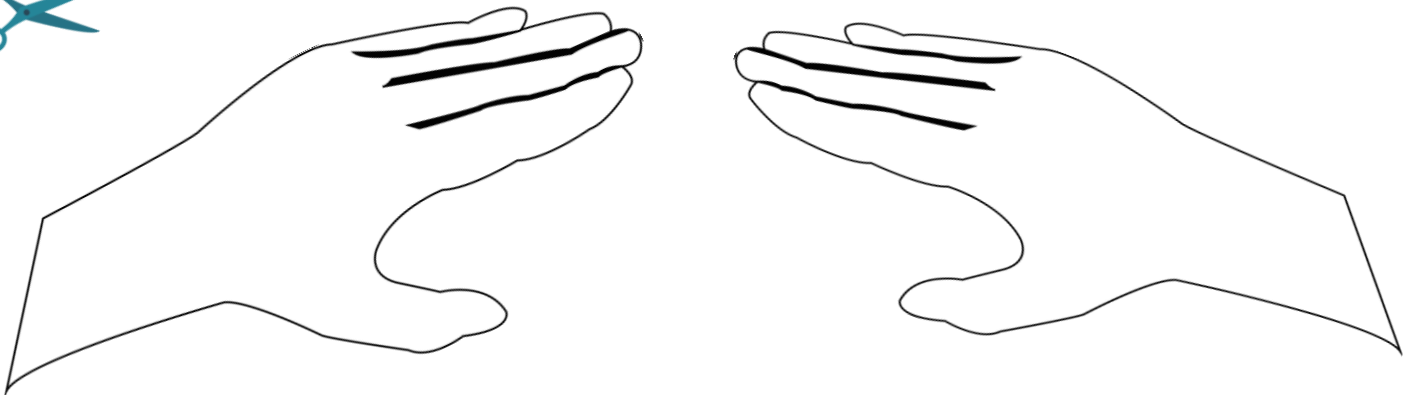
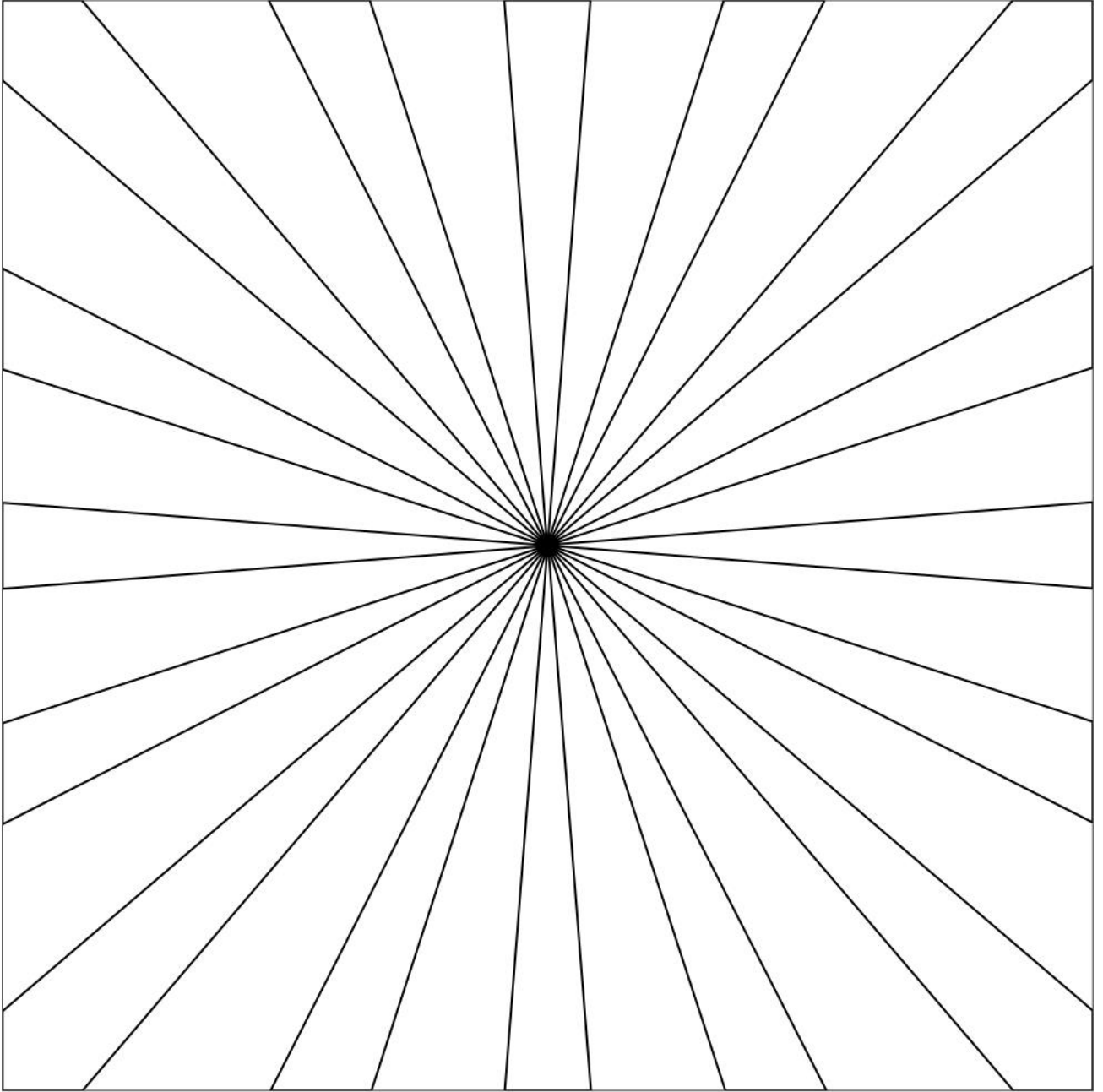
