


The final Hebrew letters or "sofit".

The final letters or "sofit" in Hebrew are like special little sisters to the normal letters. When you write in Hebrew, some letters have two forms: a normal form that is used in the middle or at the beginning of a word, and a different form called "sofit" that is used when that letter is at the end of a word.




NOTE 1: The letter Kaf, which can sound like either "K" or "Ch", when in final position or as sofit sounds, most of the time, like "J".

NOTE 2: The letter Pei, which can sound like either "P" or "F", when in final position or as sofit, always sounds like "F".

The final letter Kaf, can be pronounce as a "H" example: House, Hat, Hug.




Final or sofit Mem










Final or sofit Nun
