SALT AND LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Yeshua continues His sermon talking about the importance of making our faith and good behavior known to the world so that the world may know and praise the Creator. Read **Mattityahu 5:13-16** and circle in yellow if the behavior corresponds to good deeds and in red if it is a bad deed.



















YAHWER'S LAW DOES NOT CHANGE

Then, Yeshua talks about the law or Torah and how we must fulfill it as He did and also teach others to obey it. Read **Mattityahu 5:17-20** and then trace with colored pencil the Hebrew letters without making mistakes or changing them to discover the message written in the Torah scroll.



Read the book of **Shemot (Exodus) 20:15** and you will discover what the phrase written on the scroll says. Then write it on the line.



ANGER AGAINST THE NEIGHBOR

In **Mattityahu 5:21-26** Yeshua teaches that if we have any anger or problem with a brother, friend or neighbor we should always seek reconciliation, for this pleases Yahweh.

Help little Luke reach out to his sister to seek reconciliation.






LUST LEADS TO HELL

Another important teaching Yeshua left us was about lust. In **Mattityahu 5:27-30** we read that lusting or coveting with our eyes what is NOT ours is a grave sin. It also talks about removing from our life that which can cause us to fall into sin.

Think and draw 2 things that you think can lead us to sin (e.g. bad friendships, the music we hear, what we see with our eyes, etc.).



Trace this verse with your favorite color and repeat it out loud with your family.

For this craft you will need cardboard or thick cardboard, cellophane or colored micas and tape.
