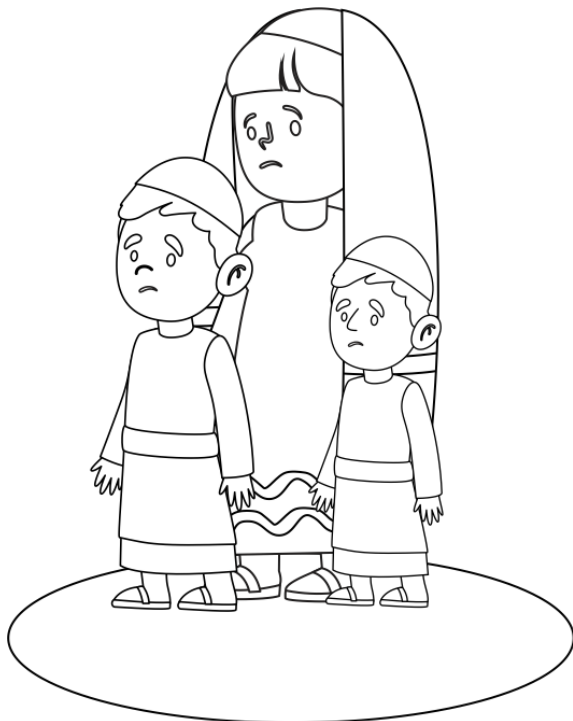




DIVORCE

Continuing with Yeshua's teachings on the mount, we learn about divorce. Divorce is the separation of a man and a woman who are married or in marriage. The context is that, at that time, some taught that a husband could divorce his wife for any reason, but Yeshua says No! But only for adultery or fornication could they divorce, not for any other reason, for even then we are called to maintain the unity of the family and to privilege forgiveness and mercy over self-pride.

To better understand this teaching read **Mattiyahu (Matthew) 5:31-32** and then read **Marqaus (Mark) 10:2-12**. Then color the family Yeshua wants us to have.

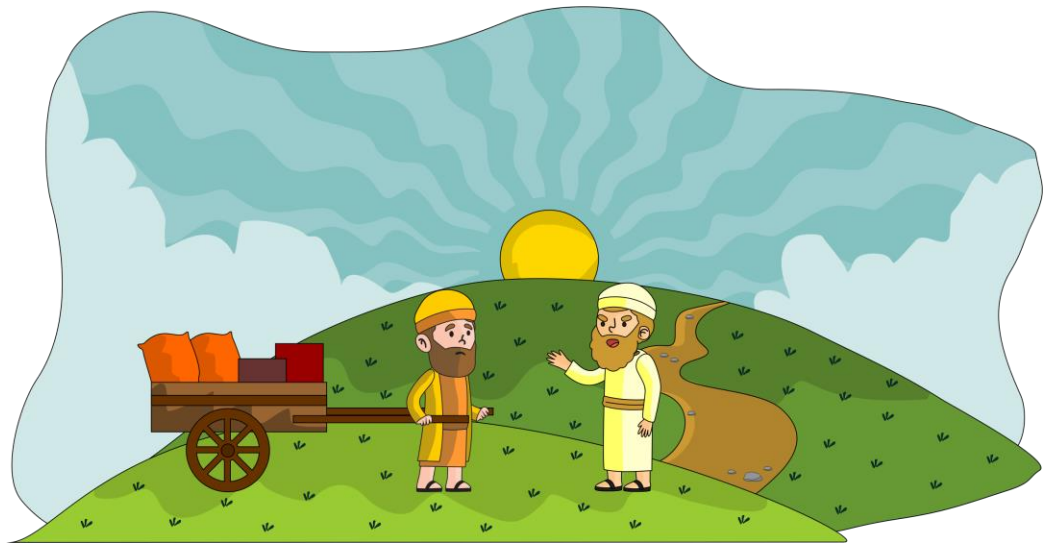

REVENGE

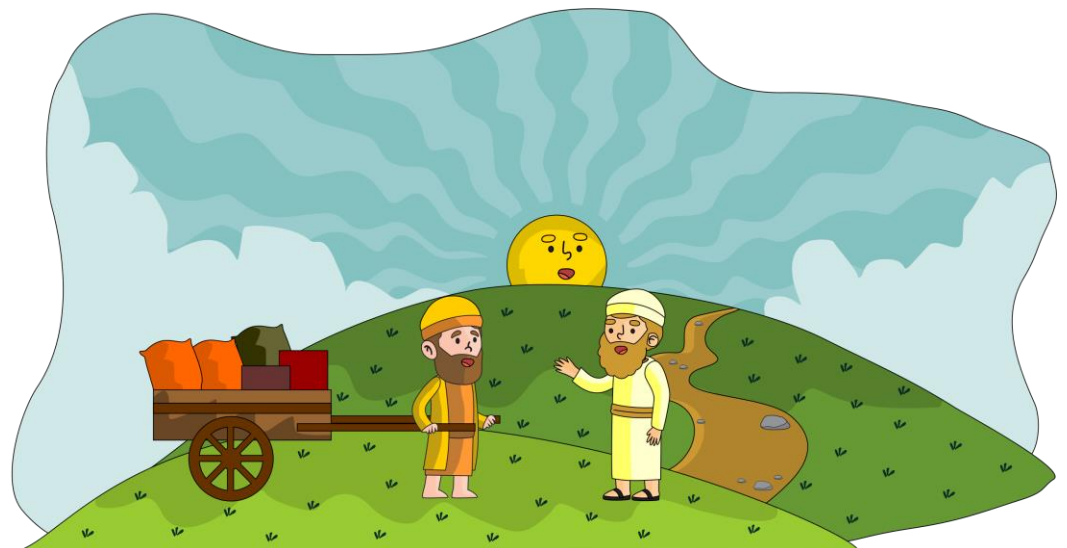
