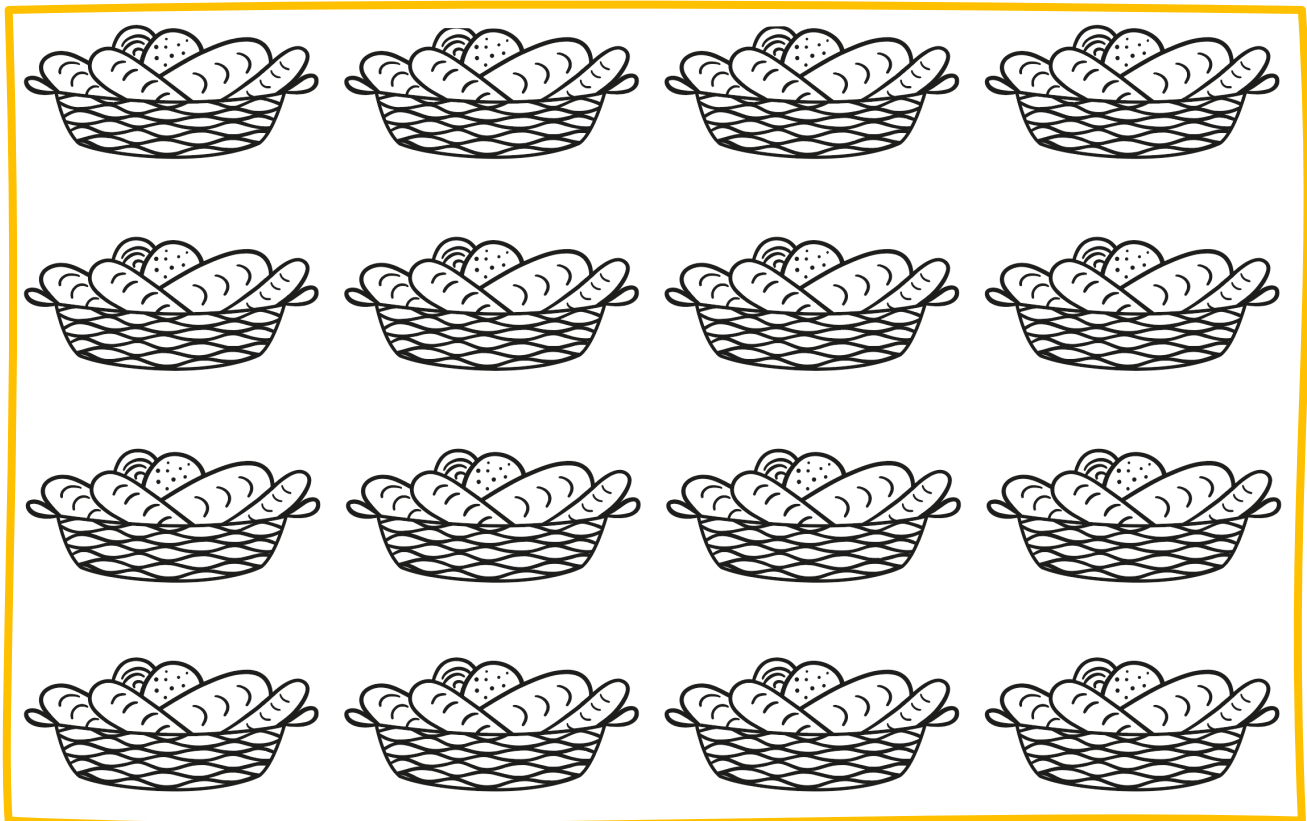

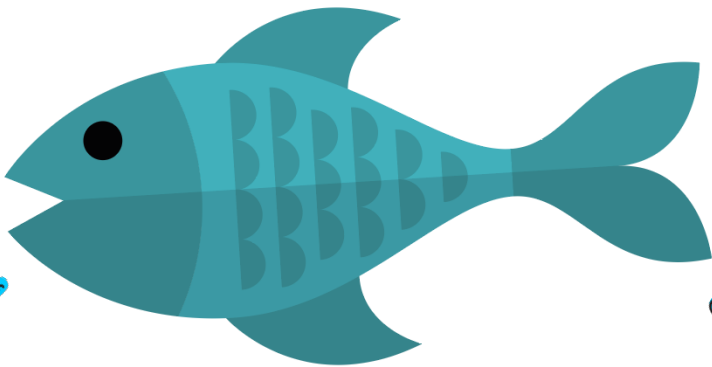


Read aloud:

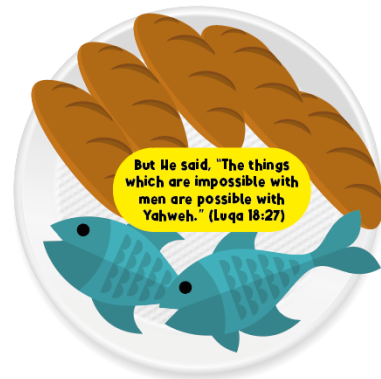
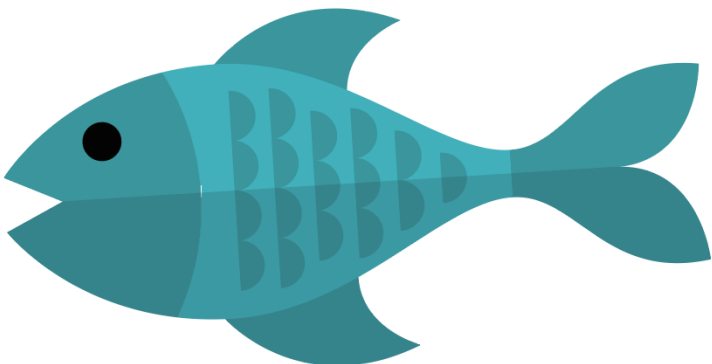
Yeshua knows and has compassion for my
