






## 2. Plague of frogs, read in the Scriptures **Exodus** (Shemot) 8:1-15

How many lice are there?








## 4. Plague of flies, read in the Scriptures **Exodus** (Shemot) 8:20-32



Draw it, but remember that this plague did not reach the Hebrew people either.








#### 8. Plague of locusts, read in the Scriptures **Exodus** (Shemot) 10:1-20
