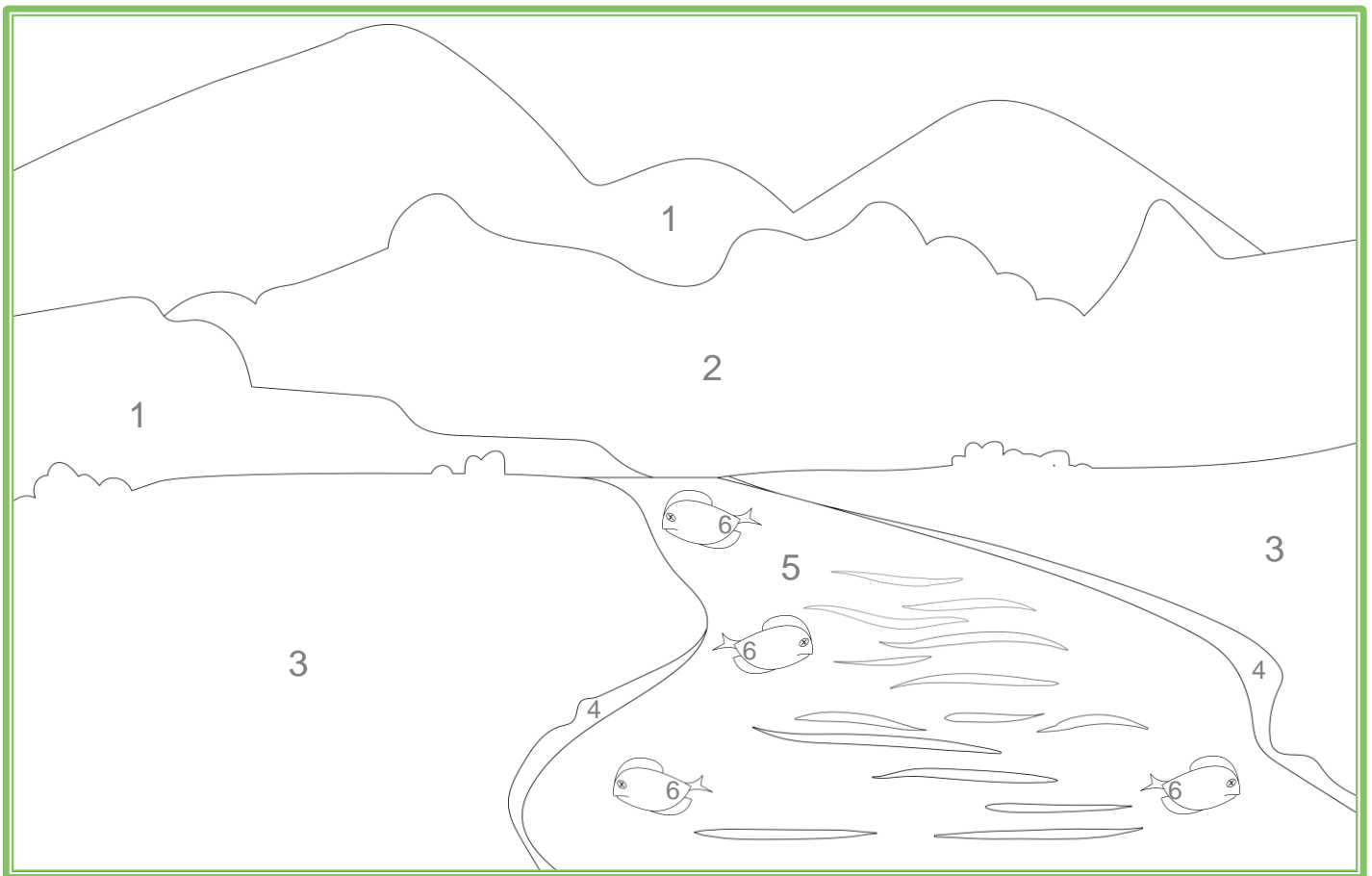

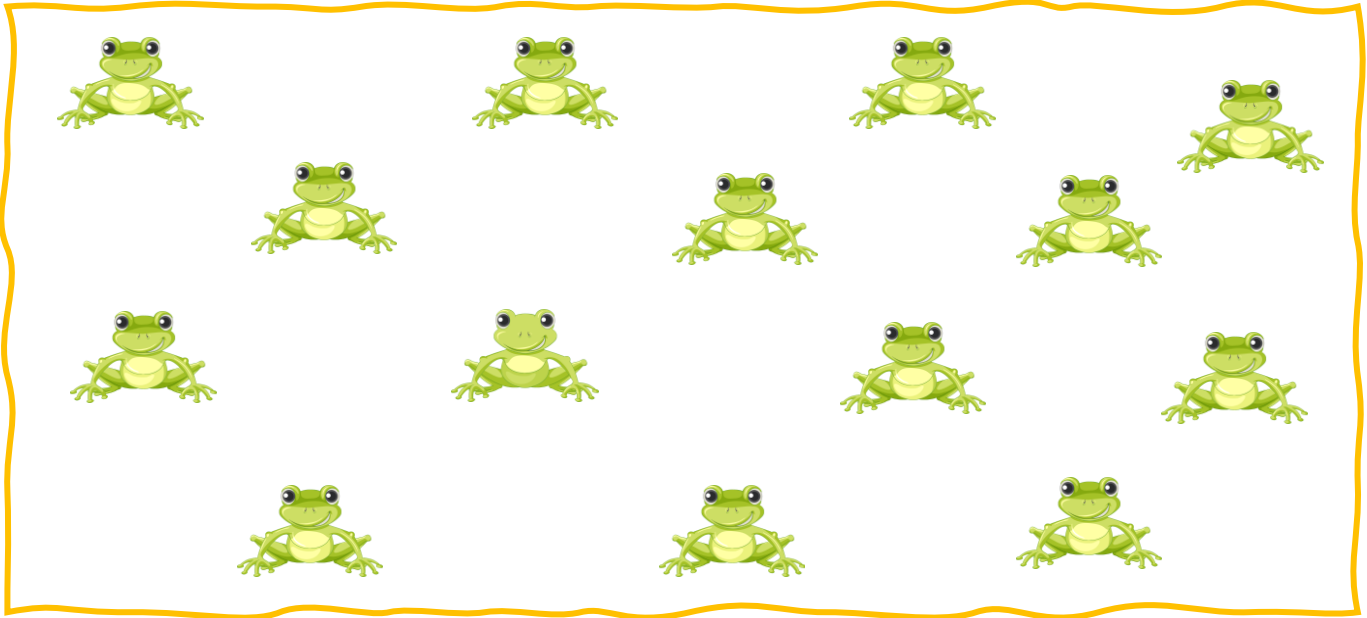

3. Plague of lice, read in the Scriptures **Exodus (Shemot) 8:16-19**

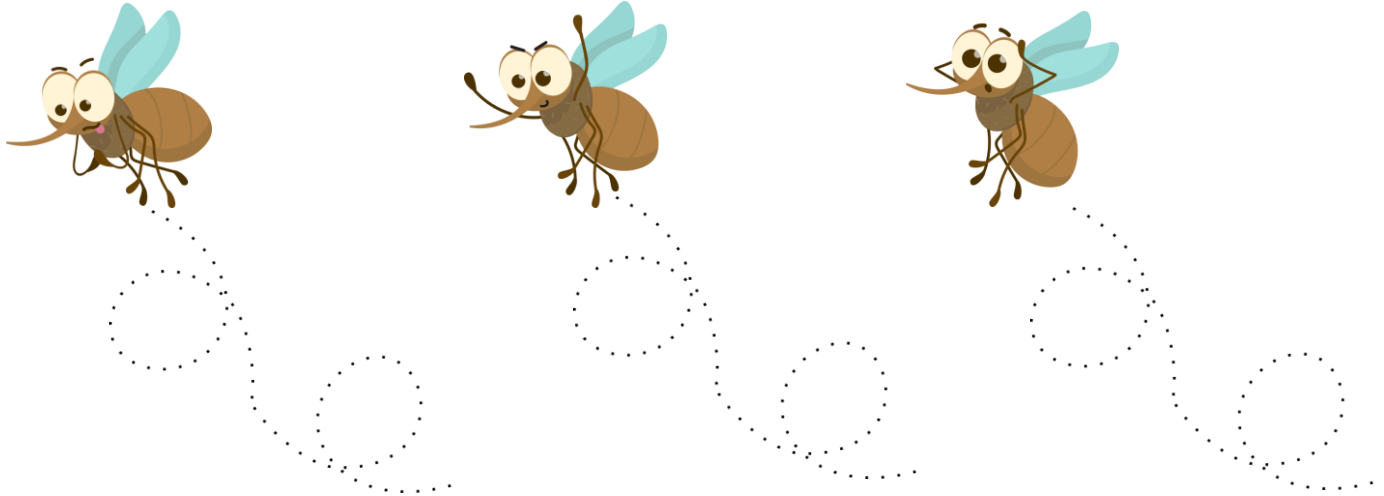
How many lice are there?

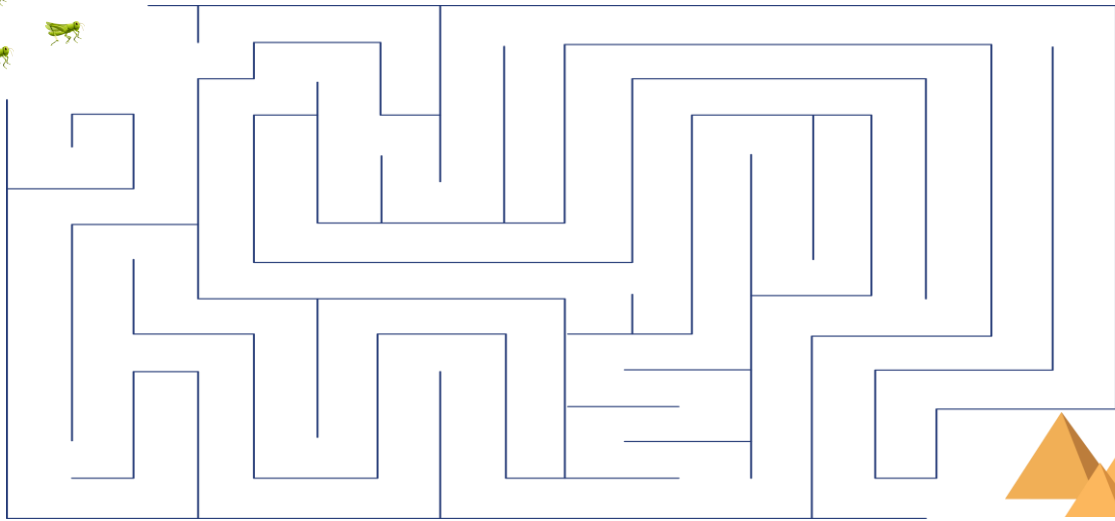
Draw it, but remember that this plague did not reach the Hebrew people either.
