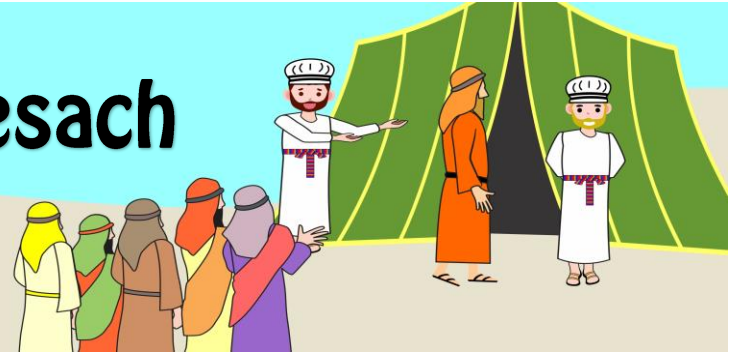




Circumcision y Pesach in Gilgal

To avoid the death of the firstborn Hebrews, they had to sacrifice a lamb and paint the doorframes with its blood. Then the angel of death **passed over** the houses whose doors had this blood on them.

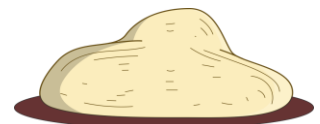
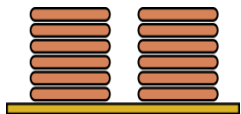

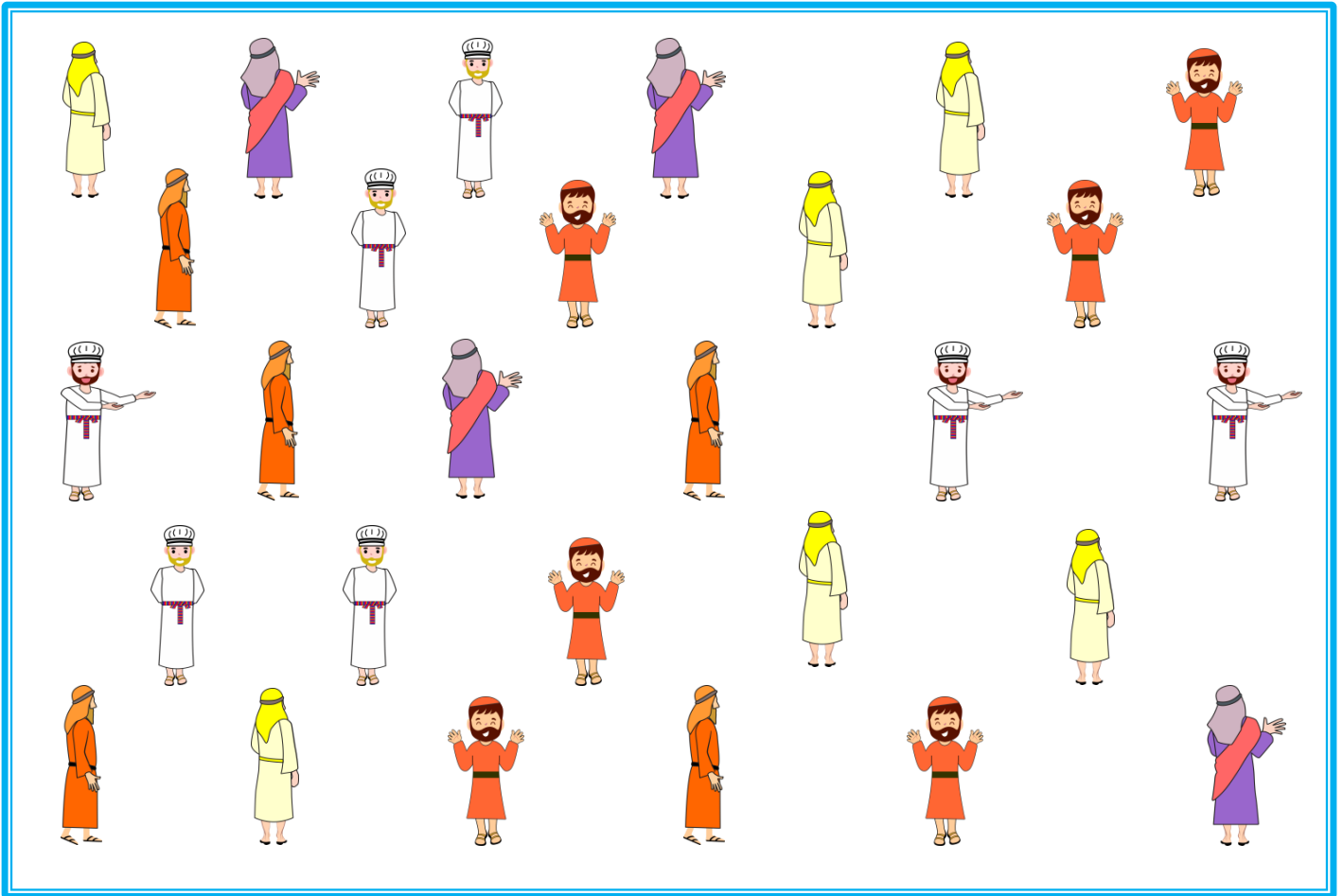
