






The men of the people of Israel had to be circumcised because they were going to celebrate the Passover (Pesach). Do you remember what this celebration is about?

Let us remember: Through 10 plagues, Yahweh freed the people of Israel from the slavery and suffering they suffered in Egypt, the last plague was the death of the firstborn.

To avoid the death of the firstborn Hebrews, they had to sacrifice a lamb and paint the doorframes with its blood. Then the angel of death *passed over* the houses whose doors had this blood on them.






