1) Who did the king call together, where did he go to and what did he do? (Mel. Bet 23:1-2)

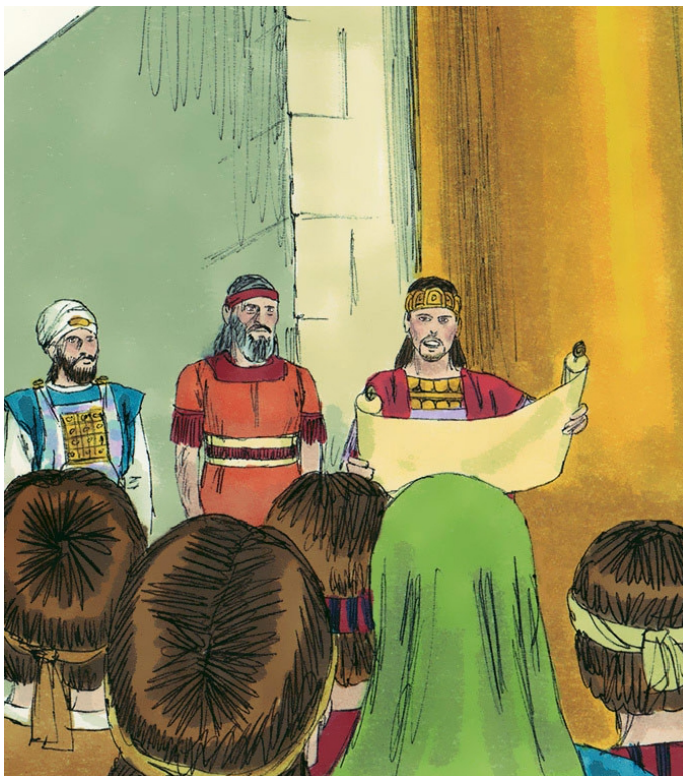
2) What did the king do by the pillar? (Mel. Bet 23:3)
