7) What animal did the anointed priest have to bring if he sinned? (Vay. 4:3)

8) Explain the ritual of the blood (Vay. 4:6-7)

9) What happened to the rest of the bull? (Vay. 4:11-12)

10) What two sin offerings were the same? (Vay. 4:3, 4:13). How was the sin offering different for when a ruler sinned? (Vay. 4:22-26)

1) When Elohim brought their fathers out of Mitsrayim (Egypt) what did he not speak or command? (Yir. 7:22)

2) What word did Elohim command? (Yir. 7:23)

3) What did they not do? (Yir. 7:24)

5) Name any abomination the children of Israel have committed. (Yir. 7:30-31)

1) What was the Torah a shadow of? (Ivrim 10:1)

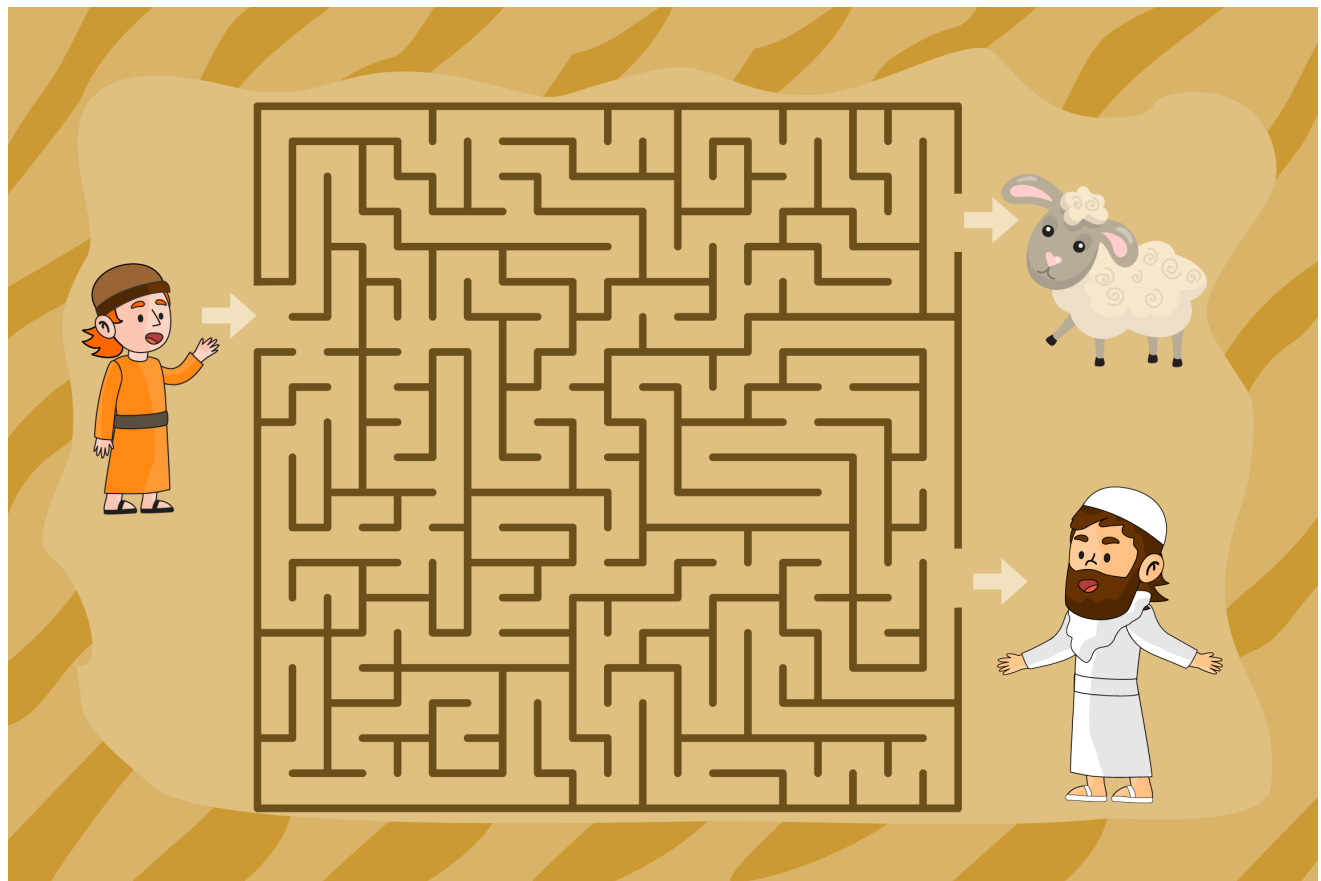
2) What were the offerings a reminder of? (Ivrim 10:3)
