

Who did the people say Yeshua was?




Trace this verse with your favourite colour and repeat it out loud.

But Yeshua answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out." Luke 19:40




Importantly, Yeshua's triumphal entry was very different from what many expected of the Messiah, a political and military leader, but rather he presented himself as a humble and peaceful King.
